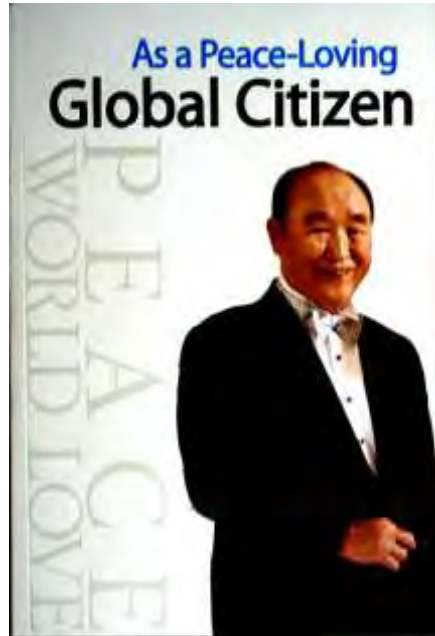

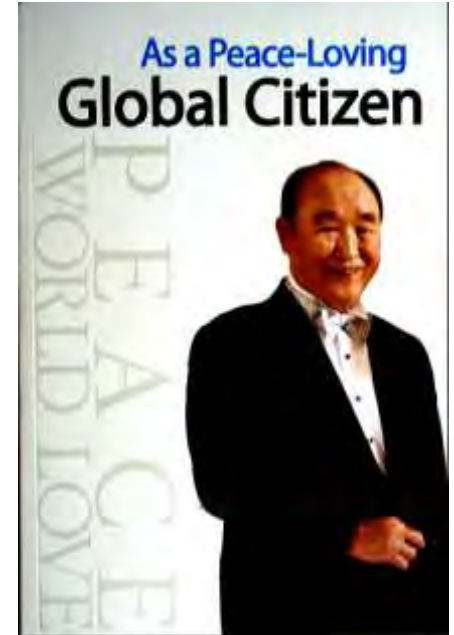

---

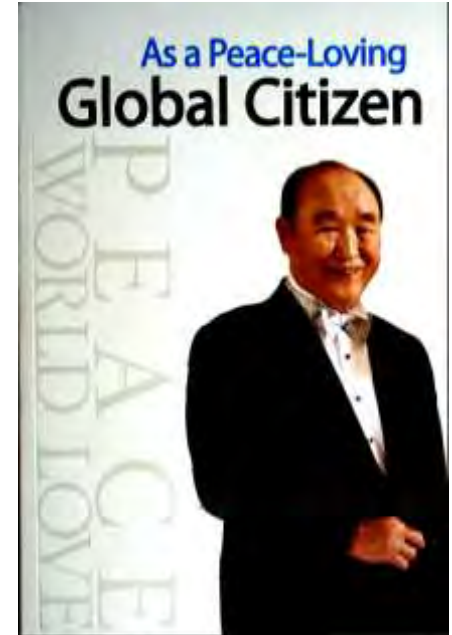
Children who do not receive true love when they are young live their entire lives hungrier for love and suffer emotional pain...

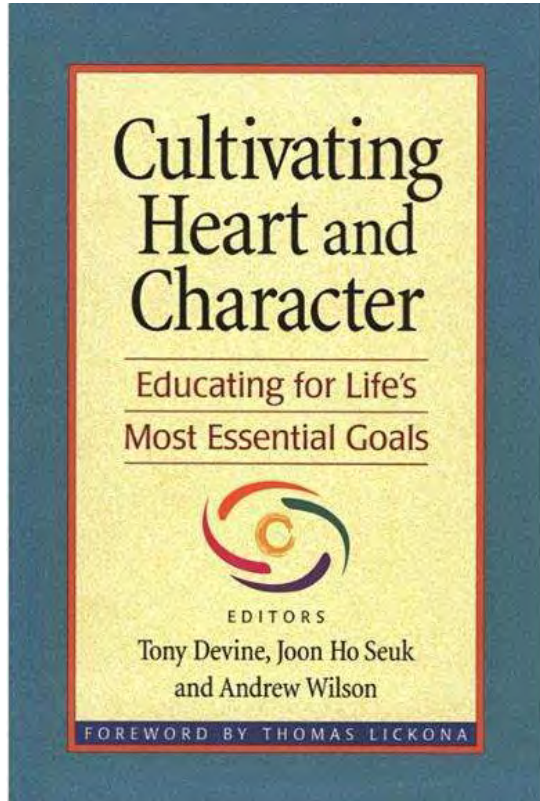


# Moral Duties Go Unlearned



# Falling birth rates could spell end of the West

The decline and fall of both the Greek and the Roman Empires was attributed to falling birth rates because nobody wanted the responsibilities of bringing up children.

# Lord Sacks' Acceptance Speech

In his acceptance speech he said, “It happened to Greece and Rome, and it can happen to the West. The sure signs are these: a falling birthrate, moral decay, growing inequalities, a loss of trust in social institutions, self-indulgence on the part of the rich, hopelessness on the part of the poor, unintegrated minorities, a failure to make sacrifices in the present for the sake of the future ... These are the danger signals and they are flashing now.”

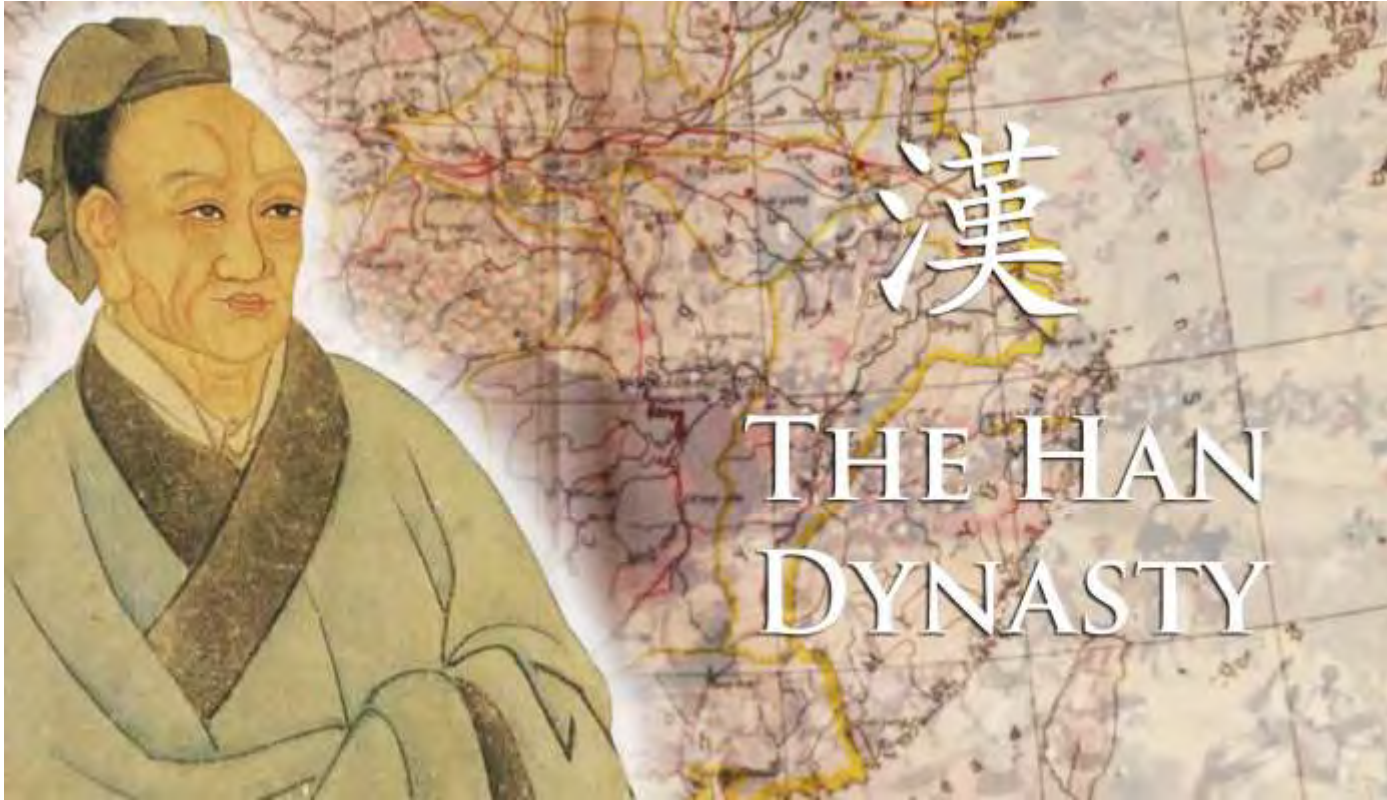

# Sexual Control and Cultural Development

---

Cultures that are polygamous but allow no divorce stagnate. Cultures that allow for divorce decline slowly and gradually loosen all sexual constraints. Then, once sexual freedom before marriage is allowed, cultures decline rapidly.

On the other hand, “Any culture that adopted a tradition of absolute, no divorce, monogamy – created energy that was transferred into growing and expanding that culture.

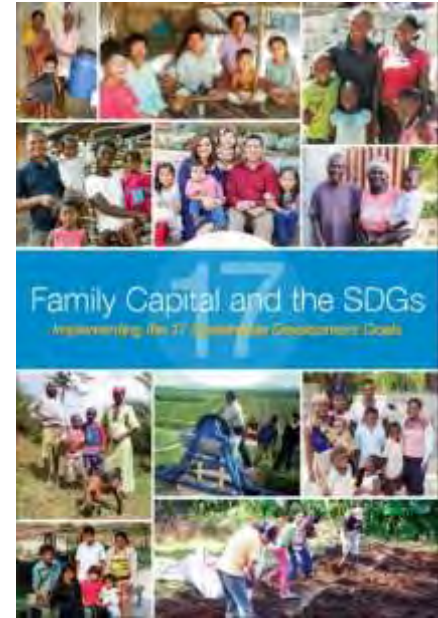

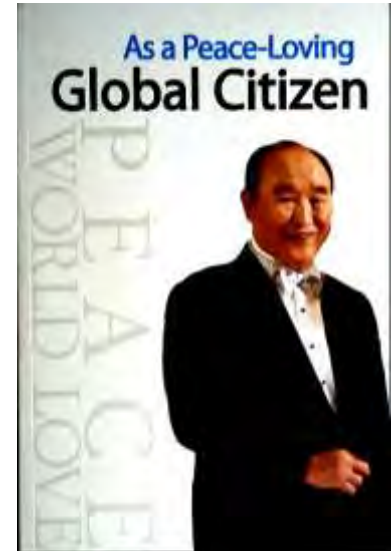
