
Original Substance of the Divine Principle




Principle of Restoration explains:

Providence of Restoration and the Messiah




Providence of Restoration through Indemnity

Definition:

When someone has lost their original position or status, they must make some condition to be restored to it. The making of such a condition of restitution is called indemnity.

Providence of Restoration through Indemnity





No one can serve two masters...

Mt 6:24

So then because thou art lukewarm, and neither cold nor hot, I will spew thee out of my mouth.

Types of conditions of indemnity

- Condition of Equal Indemnity
 Ex 21:23-25 eye, tooth, hand, root, tooth, wound, bruise
- Condition of Lesser Indemnity
 Grace of Baptism, Holy Communion, forgiveness of a debt
- Condition of Greater Indemnity
 Sacrifice of Isaac, 40 years in the wilderness

Indemnity Conditions Reverse the Course of the Fall

- Adam forsook God God forsook Jesus Mt 27:46
- Humankind rejected Jesus = Humankind should love Jesus and bear the cross
- Adam violated the Will and grieved God =
 Humankind should love the Will and comfort God

Do Not Blame God. Do Not Blame Anyone.

The Essence of Indemnity: Reversal

We begin with the conditions Adam and Eve should have made, and then the course of the Fall.

The essential Indemnity Conditions are those that reverse the course of the Fall.

The Essence of Indemnity: Reversal



Dominion over the archangel and creation establishes the harmony of Heaven and all things.

Foundation to Receive the Messiah

For fallen people to be restored to their original state, we must receive the Messiah, which requires a foundation to receive the Messiah.

Foundation to Receive the Messiah

The Foundation to Receive the Messiah includes the Foundation of Faith and Foundation of Substance, which reverse the path of the Fall.

Foundation of Faith and Foundation of Substance

Jesus taught in Mt 22:36-40

Master, which is the great commandment in the law?

Jesus said unto him, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind. This is the first and great commandment.

And the second is like unto it, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself.

On these two commandments hang all the law and the prophets.

Foundation of faith → Love God (vertical)

Foundation of substance → Love your neighbor (horizontal)

Central Figure = Adam and Eve


Condition = Abel (A & E) → Cain (AA)

Providence of Restoration in Adam's family


The Reason Adam Could Not Be The Central Figure

- He was the responsible person in the fall
- His position, serving two masters, was unprincipled
- He embodied both good and evil
- He had blamed others

Providence of Restoration in Adam's family




First and Second Born: Separation of Good and Evil




First and Second Born: Separation of Good and Evil

- When the Israelites fled Egypt, God struck the first born sons and firstborn of the livestock Ex 12:29
- In the wilderness course, only the younger sons were allowed to carry the Ark of the Covenant Num 31:25
- God hated Esau and loved Jacob even when they were in the womb Gen 25:23
- When Ephraim and Manasseh were blessed Gen 48:14

Abel's offering was accepted, Cain's was not

Foundation of Faith Love the Lord your God

Foundation of Substance Love your neighbor Central Figure = Adam ➡ Abel Object for Condition = lamb Time Period = Growing period

Central Figure = Abel Condition = Indemnity condition to remove fallen nature (Gen 4:1-8)



And in process of time it came to pass, that Cain brought of the fruit of the ground an offering unto the LORD. And Abel, he also brought of the firstlings of his flock and of the fat thereof. And the LORD had respect unto Abel and to his offering: But unto Cain and to his offering he had not respect...

that Cain rose up against Abel his brother, and slew him.



Ethics of Cain and Abel

Abel Avoid tendency to arrogance, pride, boastfulness
Be obedient and modest
Sacrifice with blood, sweat, tears to win Cain
Abel receives blessings through Cain

Cain Avoid anger, dissatisfaction, self-pity
Submit to Abel absolutely and voluntarily
Cain receives blessings through Abel

Principle of Cain and Abel



Principle of Cain and Abel

Abel Become absolutely one with God (Love)

Abel should love Cain with the love he receives plus his own love

Realize you are Cain's pathway to Heaven, even though unworthy

God can intervene only with Abel: Pray

Cain Cain contends with desires to kill.

Through Abel, God wants to teach Cain shimjung, living for others, loving his enemy.

Foundation of Faith

Vertical condition between human beings and God Central Figure = Adam → Abel (younger) → Noah

Object for Condition = symbolic offering - Ark

Time Period = growing period (12, 4, 21, 40) 120 years, 40, 21, 40 days

Horizontal condition between siblings

Central Figure = A & E, Abel, Ham (younger)


Condition = Ham Shem
Abel Cain
A & E AA
Younger Elder

Foundation of Substance


Love your neighbor: Indemnity condition to remove fallen nature

Central Figure: Ham

Condition: Elder brother's voluntary unity with Ham

The Reason Ham's Shame Constituted a Sin

Sin means to form a common base with Satan and provide him with a condition enabling him to act, thereby violating Heavenly Law.

Before the Fall Naked and not ashamed

After the Fall ashamed of nakedness

Feeling ashamed provided Satan with a condition.

The Reason Ham's Shame Constituted a Sin

Ham failed to become the Central Figure for the Foundation of Substance, and so the Foundation of Substance failed and Foundation for the Messiah failed.

Languages and races divided.

The Providence of Restoration In Abraham's Family

Before Abraham could make his offering, he and Sarah had to make a condition to restore Adam's family.

Gen 12:10-20 "Say you are my sister."



Abraham was established as the Central Figure for the Foundation of Faith.

Thus, he could make the Symbolic Offering.

Abraham-Genesis 15:9

Foundation of Faith

Love God a vertical condition between human beings and God Central Figure = Akam Akel Noah - Abraham

Object for Condition = symbolic offering heifer, goat / ram, dove / pigeon

Time Period = growing period

Foundation of Substance

Love your neighbor a horizontal condition of unity between the younger and elder Central Figure = A & E Abel Ham

Condition = Isaac Ishmael
Ham Shem
Abel Cain
A & E AA
Younger Elder

Abraham failed to cut the dove and the pigeon.

Gen 15:10 "...but he did not cut the birds in two."

The consequences of Abraham's mistake—



Then He said to Abram: "Know certainly that your descendants will be strangers in a land that is not theirs...and they will afflict them four hundred years."

Gen 15:13

If the symbolic offering had been successful,

The Foundation of Faith had to be repeated.


Isaac and Ishmael would have been central figures

for the Foundation of Substance.

Before Abraham could restore the foundation of faith he again had to make a condition to restore Adam's Family

Gen 20:1-14 ("She is my sister.")

Love your neighbor a horizontal condition of unity between the younger and elder Central Figure = A & E Abel Ham

Condition = Jacob Esau
Isaac Ishmael
Ham Shem
Abel Cain
A & E AA
Younger Elder

Foundation of Faith

Love the Lord Your God Gen 22:1-18 Central Figure = Abraham, transferred to Isaac when he offers the ram

Object for Condition = ram
(Abraham and Isaac are faithful and united;
a ram is substituted for Isaac, Gen 22:13)

Period = unknown

Foundation of Substance Love your neighbor

Indemnity condition to remove fallen nature Central Figure = Jacob (Gen 25:23, Gen 25:32-33)


Individual Level = Gen 27:1-41
Restored birthright (Elder brother Esau)
Inherited blessing (Father Isaac)
Jacob fled and lived in Haran 21 years

Family Level = Restored a family in Haran

Creation Level = Restored wealth in Haran Brought the angel to submission at Jabbok

Jacob offers everything to win Esau's heart

(Gen 32:1-20)



Esau and Jacob embrace Gen 33:1-12

Foundation for the Messiah

Lessons

- 1. Human portion of responsibility is necessary in fulfilling the will
- 2. Lessons to note
 - a. Small mistake made greater indemnity condition required
 - b. divide yourself in two to separate good from evil
 - c. cooperation between mother and son
- 3. The Path to Heaven
 - Jacob with 21 years of blood, sweat and tears, devotion and effort, he did his utmost for Esau
 - b. Esau obedience, submissio
- 4. Everything is decided in the moment
