The Washington Times Courage In Leadership Awards

The Washington Times and The Washington Times Foundation occasionally confer awards for outstanding achievement and excellence in leadership and community service. This year, we are pleased to give The Courage In Leadership Awards to several notable leaders who have shown distinction and courage in leadership in their respective fields of endeavor, often facing seemingly impossible odds. As *The Times* celebrates its 20th Anniversary representing "Two Decades of Dedication and Distinction," it is our pleasure to honor these courageous leaders.

The International Courage In Leadership Award: CESAR GAVIRIA

Cesar Gaviria was President of Colombia from 1990 to 1994 and has been Secretary-General of the Organization of American States since 1994. He was elected Councilman in his hometown of Pereira at 23. His career grew steadily, from Pereira's Mayor, to the national House of Representatives, to House leader, to co-chair of the Colombian Liberal Party, on to Minister of Finance, Minister of the Interior, and President. He is known in Latin America as a conflict mediator, democracy advocate, staunch supporter of regional integration, and defender of human rights.

The National Courage In Leadership Award: THE HONORABLE REVEREND FLOYD FLAKE

Through the Allen A.M.E. Church in Queens, New York, Rev. Floyd Flake's ministries serve tens of thousands of underprivileged residents and parishioners in the city and are models for church ministries throughout the nation. His bedrock value is the idea of self-help: help people help themselves. Rev. Flake, who was in the U.S. Congress from 1987 through 1997, is also President of Edison Charter Schools, a senior fellow at the Manhattan Institute for Social and Economic Policy, and a columnist for the *New York Post*.

The National Courage In Leadership Award: MICHAEL S. JOYCE

Michael S. Joyce is Founder and CEO of Americans for Community and Faith-Centered Enterprise, based in Washington, DC, which seeks to channel government and private funding to small, faith-inspired, social service groups. Joyce, who holds doctorates in politics and education, has served on many presidential and national commissions, including the Presidential Transition Team at the outset of the Reagan years in 1980. He is also director of The Cobalt Corporation, Harp and Eagle Ltd., The Pinkerton Foundation, and The Philanthropy Roundtable.

The Community Courage In Leadership Award: TROOPER MICHAEL MIDDLETON, CAPTAIN JERRY ROUSSILLON, CAPTAIN STEPHEN McCOY

Many more lives might have been lost on September 11, 2001, at the U.S. Pentagon, were it not for the heroic efforts of police and firefighters. Three will receive the Community Courage In Leadership Award on behalf of all their colleagues who fought to save lives on that day: Trooper Michael Middleton, Virginia State Police, and Captain Jerry Roussillon, Fairfax County Fire and Rescue Department and Captain Stephen McCoy, Arlington County Fire Department.
