
Cheonwon Temple and Cheonil Sanctum: Pillars of the Kingdom of Heaven

The Cheonwon Temple and Cheonil Sanctum stand as central symbols of *Cheonil-guk* – the Kingdom of Heaven envisioned by Father and Mother Moon. These sacred spaces embody God's original ideal of creation, serving as hubs for spiritual connection, governance, and the cultivation of a heavenly culture.

The Cheonwon Temple, also called the palace of heavenly harmony, functions as the administrative and spiritual headquarters of *Cheonil-guk*. It integrates divine principles with human leadership, guiding efforts to establish a global society grounded in true love and peace. Housing the organizational framework of True Parents' teachings, it fosters interdependence, mutual prosperity, and universal values. Its heavenly-inspired architecture invites visitors to align their lives with divine ideals.

At its heart lies the Cheonil Sanctum, a holy sanctuary representing the eternal presence of God and True Parents. This sanctified space serves as a spiritual core where individuals can offer prayers and devotion, deepening their connection with the divine. It symbolizes God's abiding presence among humanity and emphasizes the centrality of divine love and guidance in human life.

Together, the Cheonwon Temple and Cheonil Sanctum anchor the vision of *Cheonil-guk*, transforming heavenly ideals into tangible reality. Far more than architectural marvels, they embody humanity's commitment to cocreate a world of peace and unity with God, offering hope and direction to all who seek to live in harmony with the divine will.





The Cheonil Holy Paintings

To the left and right sides of the Cheonil Sanctum, the main sanctuary of the Cheonwon Temple, fourteen master artisan works depict scenes of God's providential work.

The paintings were planned and comissioned by Mother Moon between 2016 and 2023.

The artists worked with a century-old Korean technique of mother-of-pearl inlay covered with lacquer painting.





Life and Vision of the True Parents

The seven works on the left illustrate the beautiful figure of the True Parents, the returning Messiah and the only begotten Daughter.

The seven works on the right showcase the efforts of the True Parents working around the world for unity and reconciliation, building Cheonil-guk together with peaceloving leaders and families.





"At a given time, God established many righteous people in different parts of the world and has also allowed specific religions to guide these regions through these righteous people.


The aim of any religion should be to be able to explain the Creator and to deeply comprehend His essence.






Accommodation

The Han River Miracle

South Korea's Post-War Transformation

After the Korean War (1950–1953), South Korea rose from devastation to become an economic and cultural powerhouse. Strategic industrial policies focusing on export-driven growth in sectors like electronics, shipbuilding, and automobiles spurred the "Miracle on the Han River." Companies like Samsung and Hyundai emerged as global leaders, symbolizing South Korea's industrial success.

Culturally, South Korea balanced modernization with tradition. The late 20th century saw the rise of Hallyu (the "Korean Wave"), exporting Korean music, film, and drama globally. Education and innovation flourished,

The religious movement led by Father and Mother Moon also contributed to South Korea's development. The Tongil Group, a conglomerate founded by the movement, supported the industrial surge through investments in manufacturing and construction, creating jobs and bolstering the economy. Companies like Ilhwa played a role in promoting traditional Korean products, such as ginseng.

Culturally, the movement enhanced Korea's soft power through initiatives like the Little

Angels children's folk ballet and Universal Ballet, showcasing Korean traditions and blending them with global art forms. Global outreach efforts, including peace rallies and interfaith dialogues, incorporated Korean cultural elements, introducing audiences worldwide to Korea's heritage.

Sun Moon University is a unique institution in South Korea's educational landscape combining academic quality with a strong commitment to fostering global peace, ethical leadership, and cross-cultural understanding.

In the movement's teachings, Korea is positioned as a spiritual and cultural center. In fact, the Divine Principle, a key part of the message of Father and Mother Moon, offers profound insights into the deeper causal dimension behind the amazing Han River miracle, South Korea's remarkable transformation.

South Korean democracy is stable yet vibrant, marked by dynamic public participation, robust debate, and occasional political contention.

HISTORIC CONTEXT

Fertile Ground for All Religions

Religious Growth in Post-War Korea: Christianity and Beyond

The Korean War (1950–1953) catalyzed significant religious growth in South Korea, particularly for Christianity. Amid the devastation and social upheaval, Protestantism flourished as a beacon of hope and renewal. Western missionary efforts, especially from the United States, intensified, bringing humanitarian aid, schools, and medical facilities that strengthened Christianity's appeal. The faith's principles of equality, compassion, and salvation resonated deeply with Koreans, contrasting traditional Confucian hierarchies. Churches also provided displaced individuals with community and support, becoming hubs of spiritual and social recovery.

Charismatic leaders like Billy Kim and megachurches such as Yoido Full Gospel Church propelled Christianity's expansion, making it a transformative force in Korea's cultural, political, and social landscape by the late 20th century.

However, Christianity was not the sole flourishing faith in post-war Korea. Buddhism, Confucianism, traditional Korean religions like Shamanism, and new religious movements also played crucial roles. Among these, the Family Federation for World Peace and Unification, formerly the Unification Church, emerged as a prominent global movement.

Founded by Father and Mother Moon, the movement integrated Korean values of filial piety, communal harmony, and family centrality into its teachings. It emphasized peace, unity, and reconciliation, resonating with a nation yearning for healing and reunification amid Cold War tensions. Through its advocacy for "true families" and global harmony, the Family Federation contributed to Korea's spiritual and cultural diversity, shaping its post-war identity and extending its influence globally.

2025 marks 80 years of division between opposing ideologies on the Korean Peninsula, yet hope for peaceful reunification endures despite ongoing challenges.

In the Great Epic Exhibition Hall at Cheonwon Temple, the Great Epic of the Chosen Korean People will showcase the 2,000-year history of this chosen nation in 13 monumental paintings.
