
## FFWPU UK: Our Sister Rosemarie's Experience With Jesus

## Background

Our Bible study group began in October 2022 and recently completed 21 consecutive 40-day daily study periods. For 500 days, we met on Zoom every morning before reducing to 5 and later 3 days a week, allowing time to focus on outreach opportunities. One of these was the Women of Peace Together initiative - WOPTi (formerly Women of Faith Together).

We also held weekly prayer meetings to support our contacts, the BCLC team, ministers and others.

I am deeply grateful to the 50+ brothers and sisters - both 1st and 2nd Generation - from 5 countries who joined us, whether the daily Zoom, WhatsApp group, or the 24-Hour Bible Reading Challenge. I am also thankful to Pastor Adza and Nittaya Mould for their early support and encouragement and to others such as Oliver Lane who skillfully led us through the Bible Studies. Thank you very much!

I believe that it is through our shared devotion that I was blessed with such a profound and inspiring experience with Jesus.

## **Experience with Jesus**

On the 3rd day of our recent Special Great Works, Jesus appeared in my room. He was sitting on a rock and began to counsel me about my life of faith. Each point He shared was so clear and precise, delivered with such gentleness. His words were not meant to judge or criticise me but to support my growth and serve my journey.

I was deeply moved by this encounter and later reflected on the Bible verse: "...And He shall be called Wonderful Counsellor, ...Prince of Peace" (Isaiah 9:6).

Jesus emphasised the importance of having confidence saying,

"Do not doubt yourself. Do not be afraid. Go forward in faith. Trust yourself, trust God, trust Me. I am with you. True Mother is with you."

I felt His arms around me, embracing me, and I sensed that He wanted to not only embrace me but all the sisters and women of the world with His deep heart of love. Just as it says in the Bible, "As a hen gathers her chicks under her wings, I would gather you." (Luke 13:34) Jesus wants to embrace us, the New Israel,

the new Chosen People.

I also felt the unity between Jesus and True Mother. Jesus is united with True Mother because of who she is and what she has accomplished. She has fulfilled her role as the Only Begotten Daughter to the extent that Jesus is drawn to her like a magnet. It is a heavenly connection. Jesus is working with True Mother, and this cannot be changed. For those who doubt, please believe in this.

From the Bible, we see how similar True Mother's path is to Jesus'. True Mother faces similar challenges with us, the Third Israel, as Jesus faced with the Pharisees who misunderstood Him. Today, we - the Third Israel - face similar challenges in understanding True Mother. We must decide whether we will criticise or embrace True Mother's "new" Truth.

Do you remember how they accused Jesus of arrogance? Today, True Mother faces the same accusations. But she is "True Mother," with the authority to speak and share her experiences of her life and faith.

Just as Jesus performed miracles, True Mother has achieved what seemed impossible. These are her miracles. She has reached leaders in Africa, the USA, and many others through UPF. UPF belongs to True Parents; it is not separate. This is True Mother's victory!

From the Bible, we can understand how similar True Mother's course is to Jesus'. When True Mother said she came with Jesus (Bloom Festival), it is true. Jesus is drawn to her like a magnet, like a brother and sister. He is with True Mother and True Father, and they are all working together with God - our Beloved.

Jesus also spoke about the importance of removing dark energies from our bodies. He said that the only reason we cannot unite with True Parents, Jesus, or True Mother is because we cannot see from God's viewpoint. Jesus said, "Blessed are the pure in heart, for they shall see God." If we cannot see God, it is because of the impurity in our hearts.

Why are we constantly being urged to attend the CSW, the Vigil Prayers, and the SGW? The answer is: "to wash our robes." (Rev 22:14)

Who on earth has completely clean robes? If your robes are not spotless, then you have to wash them. We have to wash our robes so that we can have the "right to the Tree of Life" (Rev 22:14). But if we do not wash our robes, if we do not clean our eyes, ears, noses, mouths, throats, and hands - if we do not clean our whole physical and spiritual bodies - we cannot connect with God. We cannot see God, we cannot see from God's viewpoint, we cannot see ourselves, the world, our wives, husbands, children, neighbours, trees, gardens, lakes, mountains, forests, or the sun as God sees them because we have not washed our robes. We must wash our robes.

"The time is short. Many people do not know about True Parents. However, we, the Blessed Couples, are truly blessed - not just by title, but because in this crucial time, as God is coming to earth, we have the knowledge and the opportunity to prepare ourselves.

We have to be humble and purify ourselves. We also have to protect and love the True Family.

Did Adam and Eve make a mistake in the Garden of Eden? Yes, and there were consequences. God warned them, but did He stop loving them? No. When people make mistakes, we need to forgive them and see them from God's viewpoint.

We should love and protect the True Family and offer tears of repentance for our shortcomings.

In the Bible, Satan is called "The Accuser of the brethren" (Rev 12:10). The Pharisees constantly accused Jesus and were angry when He overturned tables in the temple. Satan will always look for reasons to accuse us and will use our fallen nature to accuse others!

To see God, we must be pure. True Mother's teaching is not false. If you keep faith in True Mother, your mind will gradually settle, and you will find inner peace.

I did not see True Father on this occasion, but his spirit was unmistakably present. It felt like a supercharged bulldozer - like Superman, but without superpowers; only his sweat and hard work. True Father is working tirelessly with an urgent heart, supporting True Mother in the spirit world.

There is no point in trying to separate True Parents. They are more than magnets - they are glued together, cemented together. It is not possible to separate True Parents. If in our minds True Father is one thing and True Mother is another, we love True Mother but do not respect Father. We love True Father but do not respect True Mother. We believe in True Father but not in True Mother. We believe in True Mother but not in True Father. This is foolishness! Nonsense! True Parents are ONE; they cannot be pulled apart.

When you are baking bread, you mix the flour and the water together; once mixed, you cannot separate them again. They are one. You cannot take the flour out of the water and make one wet and the other dry again. True Parents are like this. They are one, one heart. There is no further discussion needed.

Jesus said, "I and my Father are one." (John 10:30) He is one with God, and Jesus is also one with True Parents. God is in Jesus; Jesus is in God. True Father and Jesus are one. Jesus and True Mother are ONE.

Why do we need to wash our robes? It is so that we can be holy and join in oneness together with God, True Parents, and Jesus.

When we are holy, we can see from True Parents' viewpoint. We can see the world, the mountains, the trees, the sky, and life from God's viewpoint. But the specks and logs in our eyes, the impurity of our hearts, the sin in our bodies and minds, and the darkness prevent us from seeing clearly.

So, what is our job from now until April 13th? To wash my robes. Wash my robes, wash my robes, wash my robes! Our prayer should be, "Please help me to wash my robes."

Jesus said: "This is the message I wanted to share" - bowed and withdrew.

## A Vision

Following this, I felt inspired to offer 40 bows. When I finished, I had a vision of Jesus. He was tall, huge and reminded me of Nebuchadnezzar's statue in Daniel 2. He looked down at the UK and Europe, which appeared as areas on a world map below him.

I could sense Jesus' deep desire to step into the UK/Europe. As He raised one leg, I saw Him searching for a place to set His foot down. However, His foot hovered above the region, unable to find a resting place.

Reflecting on this, the following Bible verse came to mind: "... the Son of Man has nowhere to lay His head." (Matt 8:20) It resonated with what I was witnessing - though Jesus is ready and willing, He has nowhere to "land" to rest his foot down. Something seems to be stopping this from happening. Nonetheless, Jesus longs to work here. He is prepared. He is ready, And He is waiting.
