Michael Balcomb to Visit Unificationists in the Northeast

Like the preachers of a bygone era, Dr. Michael Balcomb, vice-president of the Unification Church USA, is riding from town to town and preaching to whomever will receive him, but this time on an iron horse heading for the Northeast.

Beginning Friday, November 30, 2012, Dr. Balcomb will travel to Bridgeport University in Bridgeport, Connecticut to have lunch at 1:00 p.m. in the Student Dining Facility and take a tour of the university. At 5:30 p.m. he will have a light dinner with the state leadership team of 10-12 people. Afterwards, Dr. Balcomb briefly will speak for 15-30 minutes, host Q &A sessions, and meet with Unificationists in Dana Hall

The next day, Saturday December 1, 2012, will begin with an 8:30 a.m. breakfast at church with members in Providence, Rhode Island. Dr. Balcomb will then travel to Portsmouth, New Hampshire and visit members at 1:00 p.m. Subsequently, at 6:00 p.m., he will meet Unificationists at church in Waterboro, Maine. He will then travel back to New Hampshire to stay overnight at the home of Rev. Richard Buessing, District Director of District 4 (Connecticut, Maine, Massachussetts, New Hampshire, Rhode Island and Vermont) in Concord.

For the last day of his Northeast circuit, Unificationists in Worcester, Massachusetts will host a "Coffee Hour" to meet and greet the vice-president. Dr. Balcomb will deliver his Sunday Service address at 10:00 a.m. Afterwards, he will travel to Boston to attend a Town Hall Meeting at the Boston Church at 1:00 p.m. A departure in the late afternoon is planned.
