

Rev. Kim's Sat Nov 16 Speech in New York City

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

We are excited to welcome Rev. Young Hwi Kim to New York City this Saturday, November 16 at the New Yorker Hotel Grand Ballroom (program starts at 10:00 AM, doors open at 9:00 AM). We are also excited to see how many brothers and sisters have committed to greet True Mother's representative and to receive his message.

However, we are already nearing capacity for this event. We currently have 569 online registrations, and the maximum seating capacity is just 600 due to fire code restrictions. Moreover, we do not even have an overflow room due to other events going on in the hotel and the Manhattan Center at the very same time. We searched all day on Tuesday for an alternate venue, but have concluded that the Grand Ballroom is still best option.

Based on this situation, we are applying the following guidelines to ensure a smooth program:

- 1. Online registration is now officially closed.
- 2. Attendees will be asked for a \$10.00 admission fee to help cover the cost of the event.
- 3. The minimum age limit for attending the event is 16 years and older.
- 4. Those who registered will have priority for seating. It's best to arrive as early as possible. Those who did not register may not be able to be seated.
- 5. Translation will be provided in Japanese (members should bring their own FM radios).
- 6. The entire program will be recorded and a video version will be available for those who are unable to participate in person this time.
