

Peace Road 2016 Unification March in Imjingak, Korea

The “Peace Road 2016 Unification March,” an expression of hope for the unification of the two Koreas and for world peace, held its closing events today in Imjingak.

About 1,200 students from 63 countries around the world participated in the event, where they recited their peace message longing for unification. They then held a DMZ barbed wire fence cutting ceremony and released doves to carry out their message of peace.

The Peace Road events, which began in 2013, expanded in scale to 14 participating nations in 2014 and 120 nations in 2015...

2016 Peace Road, in which participants rode bicycles around the entire nation, in longing for Korea’s reunification and world peace, concluded this morning at Imjingak Pavilion in Paju, Gyeonggi Province.
