Speech of Mr Jack Corley at the German Leaders' Meeting

We should have that presence of mind to write history and do our job well. We want to encourage you to do your best. Although we come from a fallen lineage, we will be the ancestors who worked with True Parents to make the conditions and lay the foundations for Cheon Il Guk. Even the United Kingdom's exit from the European Union will be forgotten – what will be remembered will be the history we wrote.

True Mother has great hopes for Europe and is paying a lot of attention to it, especially to our Second Generation. We need to find a way to inspire our youth. They will learn, as we needed to learn – they will make mistakes – but we need to trust them. The Top Gun and Universal Peace Academy programs are improving their contents, and we need to encourage our Second Generation to participate in them.
