

## WFWP Las Vegas Hosts Parenting Workshop III with Karen Ryce

WFWP hosted a special event where eighteen friends and family gathered to attend the accredited parenting course taught by Karen Ryce, founder of Happy Kids Co. and author of several books on parenting. Karen, who has over 40 years of experience working with parents and children, shared the "Seven Steps to Harmony," as ways to resolve conflicts between parent-child, teacher-child and child-child. WFWP has held several of these parenting workshops during the previous year and WFWP looks to reach out to preschools and other organizations who will be interested in connecting with Karen and WFWP.

Karen Ryce began her presentation by sharing that the most important point in resolving issues among children is to show that there is nothing to fear. The group listened to Karen Ryce as she shared her wealth of knowledge through examples and her experience. Participants broke up into pairs and did role play on how to solve conflicts in common situations. One participant shared that it is very important to apologize to one another. Another participant understood that these seven steps can be applied to resolve adult-adult conflicts as well. A third participant felt that especially men should receive this education. Everyone was able to benefit from Karen's presentation and they look forward to the next workshop in the future.
