I am excited to announce that, as we begin the school year, we are taking the next step with our Sunday School classes.

Starting this Sunday, We will have classes for High School kids (14+), older kids (9-13), younger elementary (5-8), and preschool. We are incredibly grateful for the commitment of our teachers, and we are STILL LOOKING for a few more people who can commit one Sunday a month to teach a class.

I will outline the classes and opportunities to serve below. NOTE- the age ranges are a guideline, but if your child would like to join a class for ages younger than they are (or would like to be in service) they are welcome to do so:

High School: Dr. Hentrich and Gelo Fleisher will be providing classes twice a month. The other two weeks, high school students are encouraged to join service.

9-13: Yongil Fleisher is heading up this class, and can teach once a month. He has some curriculum ideas, and we have a couple people who can assist these classes but we need a couple more people who can teach once a month.

5-8: Kendra Stein is teaching this class with a curriculum based on the Bible, and has several people to sub and support, but we are looking for 1 more person who could teach once a month, to allow Kendra to join service or take a break as needed.

Preschool: Claire Martinez is running this class by herself, and we could use at least one more person who can be with small children once a month.
