Brexit Deal Vote in the Commons on Tuesday 11th December

Ever since triggering Article 50 – part of the Treaty on European Union which began the United Kingdom's withdrawal from the European Union – Theresa May's government has attempted to negotiate a deal between the UK and the European Union. With a deal having been achieved, the Prime Minister will invite the House of Commons

to vote next Tuesday on whether or not to accept this deal.

What I do want to invite you to do is to pray for these two points:

That Members of Parliament seek God's wisdom and direction when they prepare to cast their vote

That the UK citizens can treat each other with compassion and respect, especially towards those with whom they disagree politically

By laying a Foundation of Faith (vertically connecting in heart with our Heavenly Parent) and a Foundation of Substance (horizontally connecting in heart with each other) we can lay a Foundation for the Messiah. Ultimately, the result I believe God wants is the one that best allows True Parents to bless this nation, the one that allows the nation to restore itself and establish Cheon II Guk. Since True Mother wants us to respond to the commission of becoming Heavenly Tribal Messiahs, who take responsibility for blessing 430 couples, please pray for a result that will best allow us to respond to that call.
