UK CHEONBO TESTIMONIES

Dear,

We would like to share with you all, some of the personal experiences that our UK members had during the CheonBo workshop in June.

A Testimony from a UK Member

MY FATHER

I grew up in a home with my parents and several brothers. My father had been orphaned at around 9 years old. He found work on a ship as a sort of cabin boy and later became a Constable. He was a strong swimmer and heroically saved the lives of relatives trapped at sea. He believed strongly in God and ensured that my brothers and I grew up with Christian Faith.

However, my father was emotionally unstable and reacted violently to the slightest provocation; lashing out at my mother with physical assaults, threats and a stream of verbal abuse. I only felt safe when my elder brother was at home.

Finally, after returning from School one day, I accompanied my mother to the Police Station. Soon after, we were rescued by the authorities who placed my younger brothers in a Children's Home, whilst my mother and I were moved to a secret refuge.

I was 17 when my parents finally divorced. It was a great relief! After that I did not see my father often until after the birth of my first two children.

One day I went to visit him. His living conditions were poor. He was arthritic and blind.

By then, I was aware of the many barriers and fears that surrounded my heart as a result of unimaginable scenes growing up.

Thankfully I received a lot of help from Heavenly Parent's, Key Brothers

and Sisters, support of the Heavenly Cheong Pyeong Providence, Counselling and Self-Development Programs. Gradually, step by step, with prayer and True Parent's Love, I have been able to move forward.

However, the years of violence and stress were less kind to my family and the suicide of my beloved brother was almost unbearable. I reflected on True Parents teaching about forgiveness, love, unity and family. My heart filled with compassion for my father and in spite of the challenges, invited him to live with us. However, I found the reality of this decision more difficult than I had imagined. I could not embrace him, call him, "Father" or "Dad". In addition, my dear mother could no longer visit us. But I did my best and continued to care for him dutifully.

Gratefully, during his time with us, my father expressed regret for some of his past mistakes. He participated in a full Blessing Ceremony receiving the Holy Wine and Spirit World Blessing in beautiful white Holy Robes at our Lancaster Gate Headquarters.

HYO JEONG OFFERING CEREMONY

During the 2018 U.K. Cheon Bo Event, we were told that the ancestors of all members who participated in the Hyo Jeong Offering Ceremony (Wish Paper) would receive the Special Grace of having their "Ancestors' Sins" expunged.

[to expunge = to obliterate or remove completely (something unwanted or unpleasant)]

I participated in the HJ Offering Ceremony, but with little thought or understanding of this Special Grace from True Mother. However, after arriving home, I noticed a change in my feelings towards my father which was an unexpected surprise!

My heart was light and free. I felt inspired to make my father's picture the Icon for our "Siblings" WhatsApp group. My brothers agreed.

However, I still wondered whether this experience was real or simply my imagination? Surely such profound internal change could not be the result of the Hyo Jeong Offering Ceremony...?!

However, I also saw a real change of heart and attitude in my siblings. Following my WhatsApp icon suggestion, my brothers suddenly proposed that we collectively purchase our father's Memorial Headstone to the highest standard we could afford and that I head the project!

It had been ten years since my father's funeral and we still had not managed to do this. However, now spontaneously, just three days after the UK Cheon Bo Event, my siblings were determined to do so.

HEALING GRACE

Since the Cheon Bo Event last year, I have felt a genuine WARMTH and LOVE towards my father; feelings that had long since left me. I have caught myself staring with pride at his picture; admiring his face, his smile, reflecting on his goodness and - even kissing and hugging his photo.

I no longer remember the past with ANY, negative attachment, shame, hurt or resentment – None at all!

I feel so proud of my father now and **I LOVE HIM WITH ALL MY HEART!**I would like everyone to know what a wonderful man he is and what a truly beautiful and generous heart he has.

To me, this is just like with a sink full of dirty water; when the plug is removed, all the dirty water can be washed down the plug hole and the sink is left clear & clean. Similarly, with the expunging of my ancestors' sins, all my painful memories, anger, hurt and wounds in relation to my father, have been released, "washed down the plug hole," leaving my heart free to return love and experience a more enduring peace.

For the past 16 years, I have had the privilege to quietly support, advise and mentor members of our beloved 2nd Gen and others to successfully overcome their challenges. I am not an expert, but I have been able to complete studies in Therapeutic Counselling up to University level (4), attend hours of workshops with respected world leaders in the immerging fields of therapeutic, alternative and Energy Medicines and become a Certified Practitioner in a few of the most helpful.

HOWEVER, without a doubt, my experience of Expunging of Ancestors sins has been more all encompassing and profound in its efficacy, than any other textbook, theory or modality I have so far encountered.
