Missionary dispatched to America (January 2, 1959, U.S.) 11.07 - 11.13 on the heavenly calendar (December 28 - January 3)

The Unification Church sent it first missionaries to the Western world on January 2, 1959. True Parents trained Young Oon Kim with the word, the Divine Principle and sent the professor, whose fiery passion for God's will resulted in the termination of her professorship at Seoul's Ehwa Women's University, to the State of Oregon in the U.S., as a pioneer missionary. During his first world tour, True Father complimented her in the San Francisco church, saying that she "gave everything day and night with strong determination to sow seeds of the Principle."

First publication of *News World* (New York, U.S. December 31, 1976) 11.07 – 11.13 on the heavenly calendar (December 28 – January 3)

The first issue of *News World* was published in New York City on December 31, 1976. On this occasion, True Father said, "We must create a newspaper company that can spread the word about universal justice in God's name." This newspaper, which surprised the entire nation by reporting before the end of the presidential election in 1979 that the Republican presidential candidate, Ronald Reagan, had won, changed its name to the *New York City Tribune* on April 4, 1983.
