16:10 A Vision for Peace in the 21st Century, Dr. C.H. Kwak

Dr. Chung Hwan Kwak is Co-Chairman of the Presiding Council of the Universal Peace Federation (UPF) and Chairman of the World Association of Non-Governmental Organizations (WANGO). He has served and continues to serve as the head of a number of international organizations and academic institutions, including the Professors World Peace Academy, the World University Federation, Sun Moon University, the University of Bridgeport, the International Religious Foundation and the International Relief and Friendship Foundation. He has served as Vice Chairman of the Korean daily newspaper, Segye Ilbo (World Times), and is Chairman of the Board of United Press International. He has published numerous articles and books on a wide range of topics, many of which have been translated into several languages. Rev. Dr. Kwak has lectured widely throughout the world. He holds advanced degrees in Law, Western Philosophy and Theology.

16:40 The European Union, a Model for Peace and Prosperity, Dr. W.F. van Eekelen

Dr. Van Eekelen has represented the Dutch Foreign Office in India, the UK and Ghana, has been member of the Parliament, State Secretary of Foreign Affairs and Defense, Dutch Minister of Defense, Secretary General of the West European Union (WEU) and fulfilled many other important functions. Dr. Van Eekelen is a strong advocate for the Atlantic co-operation and EU. He is very active in support of the European Union, in particular in connection to the Netherlands Advisory Committee on European Integration.

17:10 Education of Character and Family Values, Drs. L.A.C. Baroness van Tuyll van

Serooskerken. Mrs. Van Tuyll is a child psychologist and child therapist. She has become renowned as an expert in the field of adoption of children from abroad and has been working as a senior adoption consultant (Triade Consultancy). Her knowledge about and experience with children and adoption has given her valuable insights in the important role of family values. Baroness Van Tuyll lives next to the castle "Slot Zuylen", where her ancestors lived for about 300 years. Recently she became president of the "Foundation Slot Zuylen", which has become a famous museum.

17:30 Service Projects in Ghana, Mrs. M. Bos. Mrs. Bos is a member of the "Foundation Ghana Haarlem", a partner of the "Community Partnership for Youth and Women Development" in Ghana. Western and African knowledge are combined to improve education and living circumstances in Ghana, especially for women and youth. The organisation in Haarlem is preparing volunteers from The Netherlands to work in Ghana and accompanies them and Ghanese volunteers in community activities.
