Please bring warm clothes, house shoes/slippers, notebook and pens. Please bring a sleeping bag.

There are only approx. 50 Spaces Available. Please register early, as we accept participants on a first come, first served basis.

Travel to Cleeve House:

The workshop site is at Cleeve House (*address: Cleeve House, Trowbridge Rd, Seend, Melksham, United Kingdom, SN12 6PG*). A historic home in the West of England (near Stonehenge and Bath) approximately 2 hours outside of London.

The closest airport is Bristol Airport – this would be the best if possible. Of the London Airports, Heathrow, Gatwick or City are the best options. We do not recommend travelling to Southend, Stansted or Luton – but choose the best option possible for you.

We will send more travel information based on your registration, so that you can make the best travel plan from your journey to Cleeve House from the Airport using public transport.
