Power of Blood and Seed

In recent years I spent time with President George H.W. Bush, and it was usually related to True Father. Actually GHW and me are both from Midland, Texas; plus, I had attended high school with Laura Bush, his daughter-in-law. One day we were talking in his Houston office when, out of the blue he drawled, "You know, Larry, I like Reverend Moon but why does he always have to talk about sex organs?"

The answer seemed obvious. "Mr. President," I said, "What is the one thing that, since the dawn of history, has destroyed men and women, destroyed their marriages and families, even destroyed kings – (pause) – and presidents?" (This discussion was during the height of Clinton's infidelity.)

He didn't say anything for several long seconds. And then, "Good point."

To answer GWH, the fact is sex is exactly what the Messiah needs to talk about. It really, really is the central problem of everything. It's what God cares about. People too, based on internet search statistics. As often awkward and difficult as it is to talk about it, anyone who wants to get real about life on earth has to at some point address the issue without flinching.

I am proud of True Father's willingness to go where many religious leaders will not. It shows he understands, he cares; he's not weak.

Neither is Hyung Jin Nim, and last May he popped the hood on the topic of the famous "six Mary's," calling the situation the "big elephant in the room" that people are uncomfortable to talk about. He called it a "core" issue, and exhorted people to not be ashamed of it.

I'm not.

True Father said he never misused his sexual organ, and that's good enough for me. At the same time, the six Marys are not fictional characters. They exist. Restoring Eve through six stages was either True Father's strategy that God approved, or it was God's plan from the get-go. While I develop a better understanding of it, my job is to be a man of faith. Bottom line: I trust my Father and believe he is who he said he is. I am not ashamed of True Father. I trust God's manifestation in True Parents.

Hyung Jin Nim said last May, "The fastest way for God to destroy the blood lineage that has covered this world from Satan's seed is for God to re-seed the world." Aside from simply killing everyone, the most efficient way to establish the "Millennial Reign" is for Christ to "come and take all the women of this world and be their spouse, and to have children from every single one of those people – and kill off Satan's blood lineage."

He also said that despite what Divine Principle teaches, "When Christ comes, he comes as God."

He said that God, being the Creator, is the true owner of me and also the true owner of my wife. He added, "If we truly love our spouse we would have no problem saying, 'I want God to love my wife more intimately... and deeply and eternally than I ever could imagine.'" That's basic Three Day Ceremony 101, and we're fine with that.

He said, "I'm not talking about this only symbolically. I want God to dwell with her [my wife] and be intimate with her all the time. As any human man, we cannot compete with the love of God." This last sentence is simply not true because it denies the perfection of Adam. The hope of every woman is that her husband will carry the complete love of God and deliver it to her. In return, she will deliver the lineage.

To his credit, Hyung Jin Nim added, "I am the successor to True Father, [but] that does not mean I have six Mary's. Because I am not the Messiah. Yes, Father has transferred his authority to me, but that doesn't mean I complete his mission because his mission is already complete. And because I am not the Messiah and I am not God, I have to do what God tells me when it comes to my sexuality. And that is, just my wife. We don't continue on a dispensation which is already complete." Well said.

That's reassuring to hear, but forgive me if I wave the caution flag, because Hyung Jin Nim's theology seems to be evolving. For example, a few weeks ago on October 4, Tim Elder announced that Hyung Jin Nim and Yeonah Nim are the True Parents – in exactly those words.

Tim, head of the World Mission Department of Sanctuary Church and designated narrator for momentous occasions there, made a special announcement preceding Hyung Jin Nim's sermon. Tim proclaimed "the physical manifestation of True Parents on earth in Hyung Jin Nim and Yeon Ah Nim."

Appearing to have a need to make this point crystal clear, Tim added, "He is True Parents. He is True Parents on this earth, and we need to understand that here at Sanctuary Church, and hope everyone watching this video will also understand, that Hyung Jin Nim and Yeon Ah Nim today are the True Parents."

Tim concluded with, "That's pretty heavy, but we need to be very clear about this and I wanted to make it clear today." What is Tim clarifying exactly? That Hyung Jin Nim is True Father's successor? No. The three separate crowning ceremonies pretty much took care of that. So what is it that's "pretty heavy" and that warrants special clarification? The difference is the statement that they ARE the True Parents.

That's very different language from what we've heard before.

Some of us have wondered what we would eventually call True Father's successor and his wife, title-wise. Surely not Mr. and Mrs. Successor. President or Bishop work well. Pope is accurate, but it's already taken. He seems to have settled on King, which is his ultimate destiny. And now, suddenly, he is True Parents. This is new and an incrementally higher rank, elevating them from "represents" to "is." Will we have trouble getting used to that? Do frogs placed in a pot of cold water notice it slowly getting warmer over time?

Hyung Jin Nim has already said that Yeonah Nim has stepped into the position of True Mother when "the Han Mother" failed and left her position. So now she's the True Mother, and Hyung Jin Nim, being the male half of the True Parents, must now be the True Father. In a few more minutes, after the water heats up a bit, we frogs won't be able to tell any discernable difference, and Hyung Jin Nim will be "True Father" at Sanctuary Church. The replacement of True Parents is complete. That was the goal, right?

Then there was Hyung Jin Nim's statement last May that, "everything has been accomplished [by True Father]."

Forgive me if I reach for the caution flag again for the following reason. If everything has been accomplished by True Father, it's odd that Hyung Jin Nim is now saying that, due to the betrayal of the Han Mother, there now need to be three kings. True Father was the first, Hyung Jin Nim is the second and his son as the third King will complete the kingship mission. This is Hyung Jin Nimic mission-creep. Which, by the way, puts True Father in the position of Saul, who was a failure.

Can you understand why Hyung Jin Nim's directional trends make me nervous?
