He then showed a video of Hyung Jin Nim and Kook Jin Nim at a benefit hosted by General Michael Flynn at President Trump's Mar a Lago estate. Hyung Jin Nim gave a performance at the end, shown in the 7 minute video of the organizers.

Gregg then spoke about True Father's Danbury course, starting with a "tax evasion" trial in 1982. He was found guilty for allegedly failing to pay a few thousand dollars in taxes, while investing hundreds of millions to protect America through *The Washington Times*, which had just been founded in May 1982. He could have avoided the trial by staying in South Korea, but Father chose to immediately fly back to America to face the charges. He was sentenced to 18 months in prison.

When, despite forty amicus briefs from mainline Christian leaders, legal associations, civil liberty groups and state governments, the Supreme Court refused to hear the case, he prepared to go to jail.

The US Justice Department wanted to negotiate with Reverend Moon's attorneys. On the condition that Reverend Moon depart for Korea and never come back to the United States, they said, the government would waive his prison sentence. He flatly refused. His comment was, "It must be God's will that I go to prison. There must be a providential reason why I must go this way."

Meanwhile he conducted 2 international Blessing ceremonies for thousands of couples as well as the International Conference on the Unity of the Sciences and the CAUSA Victory Over Communism conferences.

During this satanic attack he maintained absolute momentum to resist what we now recognize as the Deep State. Father experienced imprisonment and tortures in Japan, North Korea, South Korea, and America. Nothing was able to stop him.

Gregg finished by reading from [Ed Farmer and Bill Shepherd's testimonies](#) about meeting Father in Danbury prison published in January 1984 *Today's World* magazine. Here some excerpts from Ed Farmer:

I was fortunate. I only had to be in Danbury for three months. I knew I was going, and I knew Reverend Moon was there. They had it in the paper every other day. I was curious. As it turned out, I was in the

cubicle right next to Reverend Moon's, five feet away. Reverend Moon has a very good sense of humor. It's hard for me to think of a person as being mean or brainwashing people with the sense of humor he has. He truly loves people. I mean, he likes being with them. He likes being kidded, he likes being teased. I never saw a mean act on his part. He never asked for special treatment. He mopped floors, cleaned tables, and he helped other people when he was finished with his job.

When you'd be down in spirit, he's come along, pat you on the back, and smile and laugh. He doesn't put on a face today, or put on generosity or kindness today and then not tomorrow. Reverend Moon is Reverend Moon, a very steady, ongoing force. I think that man could be happy wherever he went. He carries his religion with him. He doesn't need a book. Everyone feels it. It's very evident.
