MATCHING ADVISORS TRAINING JULY 30, 2011

The Blessed Family Ministry is Seeking Experienced, Motivated and Mature
Blessed Members (1st and 2nd Generation)
to Support Candidates and their Parents' in the Matching Process

The new matching guidelines for this era of settlement include the clear role of parents in their adult children's matching process, greater ownership by the candidates themselves for the process and final decision, clear steps and a time period, and experienced matching advisors, trained and certified by HQ, to assist 1st and 2nd Generation candidates and their spiritual or physical parents in the matching process. With the guidance of our President and Senior Pastor, Rev. In Jin Moon, a new system of comprehensive Blessing education, parents' matching convocations, websites, and handbooks have been developed to convey and support this new matching process.

A one-day training and certification for prospective matching advisors is scheduled for the NY/NJ area this Saturday, July 30, 2011, from 8:30 AM to 5:00 PM at HSA-UWC National HQ, in Room 601 of the new Yorker Hotel, 481 Eighth Avenue, New York, NY, 10001. Because of available space and the urgent need for support for candidates and their parents, we can welcome additional participants to this comprehensive program. It will be led by Rev. Phillip Schanker, director of the Blessed Family Ministry in the USA. The training is free for qualified participants. Lunch and snacks are included.

A prospective matching advisor should feel called to this ministry, and be trustworthy, faithful, a good listener and patient communicator. They should be happily Blessed themselves, and be able to schedule a few hours of availability on a regular basis. Advisors will be trained to help candidates and parents develop a clear plan for the matching process, assist them in finding potential candidates, and support them through the process as needed. The BFD will provide the handbook, interview forms and support materials, and will train and certify matching advisors, according to the international guidelines.

Church leaders and BFD representatives are not automatically qualified as MAs based upon their position alone. Each advisor should be trained, become familiar with the guidelines and process, and be certified by the National Blessed Family Ministry. They will work in cooperation with a network of advisors, utilizing Parents Matching Convocations, an international matching website, the "Matchbook" website and the new Online Matching System (OMS) for First Generation, in support of candidates and families.

Advisors will work on a volunteer basis, according to their own schedule and availability, and should freely develop their "gift" for this ministry. But they should work according to the international guidelines, and report to their local or district BFD. MAs do not make "absolute matches," but support parents and candidates in the process. Advisors can specialize in one or more of these categories:

First Generation Unificationists
First Generation 40 years and older
Jacob Generation
Associate Members
Treasures of Heaven [Special Needs Candid.]
Getting Back on Track
International Matchings
All of the above
