During the launch of the <u>Mother Foundation</u> on February 4, WFWP was asked to go on stage with Senior Vice-President of WFWP International Dr. Sun Jin Moon and receive a certificate from True Mother. "When we received a monetary gift, we realized True Mother is truly investing in these organizations!" said President Selle.

The International Association of First Ladies for Peace (IAFLP) was launched successfully on February 4 despite concerns surrounding the coronavirus outbreak.
