Preview the Speaker's Topics:

Our first panelist, **Professor Min Gyu Kim**, is a graduate of Kim II Sung University in North Korea, and is currently a Visiting Professor of National Defense at Woosuk University. He was previously a member of the North Korean Foreign Ministry, and was a North Korean diplomat to Russia. In 2009, he escaped to South Korea, where he attended graduate school at the University of North Korean Studies in Seoul, and worked as a reporter for the Chosun Ilbo newspaper.

During his presentation, Professor Kim will debunk some of the prevailing clickbait stories, such as the treatment of athletes in the Olympics. Additionally, he will shed light on the existing culture of North Korea, and the distinctions between classes within the city of Pyongyang.

Ms. Hee Ryang Cheon is a third generation North Korean living in Japan. She was raised within a Korean community, and attended Korean schools until high school.

Ms. Cheon will be sharing about the perspective and history of the Korean "Chosun" schools she attended growing up in Japan, and the important qualities these students have to contribute during the era of unification.

Mrs. Son Ja Han is the Head of the International Solidarity for North Korean Human Rights, and has assisted with rescuing defectors and integrating them into South Korean society.

Mrs. Han will introduce her story having been born in North Korea, but raised in China. She will describe the harsh situations she witnessed when visiting her family members in North Korea. She will also recount one of her rescue missions, and the challenges faced along the way.

The final panelist, **Ms. Rosa Park**, is the Director of Programs and Editor at the Committee for Human Rights in North Korea (HRNK), a U.S. based civil society organization. Through her work with HRNK, Ms. Park has conducted interviews with Korea experts and North Korean escapees, and directs conference and public outreach programs in the United States and abroad.

During her presentation, Ms. Park will be sharing her family background and her

perspective as a Korean American born in the United States, findings about women escapees through her work with HRNK, and what we can do now to prepare for the unification of the Korean Peninsula.
