Seeking Talented Young Artists!
Sadly, 70 years after the outbreak of the Korean War, North and South Korea are still divided. Let us imagine a world where there is peace between the two Koreas, and express that hope through the power of art!

Color My Heart with Peace is a project to encourage self-expression and foster the hope of peace among our children through cultivating their talents in the field of visual arts.

Peace Art Contest
For young artists aged 7-11 (born 2008-2012).

Art Media and Format
Artworks must be done on 100-pound paper in A3 size (30cm x 42cm).
Acceptable media: Watercolor, drawing, acrylic paint and crayon.

EVALUATION CRITERIA

- Creativity 30%
- Interpretation of the theme 30%
- Overall impression of the artwork 20%
- Facebook Likes 20%

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES
Contest starting date: **21 October, 2019**
Deadline for submissions: **6 December, 2019**
Announcement of winners: **13 December, 2019**

SUBMISSION PROCESS
Upload a scanned picture of the artwork on the **Color My Heart with Peace** Facebook page (<http://www.facebook.com/2020dms/>) along with the hash-tagged nationality, name, age of the artist and title of the artwork.
(example) #Argentina #HannaTaylor #8 #OurPeace

WFWP staff will contact winners or winners' guardian/parents regarding the process of shipping the original artworks to South Korea.

AWARDS
Winning artworks will be exhibited in South Korea in January 2020. The Gold Award Winner and a guardian will be flown to Seoul, Korea to attend the exhibition. Flight tickets and accommodations will be provided by WFWP OR a iPad Pro with a Apple Pencil.
