HOW TO HOST A WATCH PARTY



Pick a date and time

Premiere is December 18th, 2021 2pm PT/5pm ET. Hosts will be emailed a link and password to access the show. If you would like to livestream on Dec. 18, you can simply go to BlessingFest.org on the day.



The venue will need a screen, seating, and ideally a bathroom. We recommend your home, but make sure your space has adequate sound. Transit options and parking are also key considerations for your guests.

HOW TO WATCH

Don't do it alone! Recruit people to help. Minding the details is a multi-person task.

Set up the space. The film is about 45 minutes long with discussion after, so make sure people can get comfortable.

Sketch out a timeline for the event. The main event is all set. Think about how you want to structure the time around the film. Plan an icebreaker. Prepare a short welcome about yourself and your Blessing story. Give guests time to fill out a feedback survey at the end. Think about how you want the conversation to flow.

Build in time for informal connections.

Create a comfortable space for people to share and get to know each other. This will make for a more enjoyable viewing experience and rich discussion later on.

Checklist

- ☐ Finalize the location
- Invite guests at least 1week before the party
- Send directions to the venue
- Check your internet connection

- Sound check
- Prep food and beverages
- Pick someone to capture the party. Tweet, Snap, Instagram, etc!
- Print out surveys for guests to fill out or share the survey link after the show

Things to Think About

- Who is your audience? Are they married? Single? In a relationship? Have kids?
- Do you have a variety of seating options. Offer chairs with and without arms.
- What equipment do you need?

- Do guests have food and drink preferences? Make sure there are options and clear labels.
- Do you have bathrooms available?

Of course this list does not cover everything. Mind the details and be thoughtful. Recruit some folks to help think through the evening and catch some details you might overlook.

DISCUSSION GUIDE

Tips for Facilitating



Ensure everyone has a voice. At the start of the conversation, share that you may have to interrupt or invite someone to speak. If it happens, it's not personal.



Silence is OK. People need time to gather their thoughts to respond to a question. If silence persists, try rephrasing or reframing the question, or ask if people would like clarification.



Your responsibility is the process.

If people have questions about content, you don't have to be the expert. Someone else in the conversation may be able to respond. If someone directs a content question to you, a way to draw others in is to ask, "What do other people think?"



Build trust and listen. These questions are designed to build a relationship of trust. Keep in mind that if you share about your own experiences, center it on the Blessing. Be open to where your guest is at and their own experience.

DISCUSSION GUIDE

Guiding Questions

- What do you think it takes to make a marriage last?
- What helps you work through the rough patches of your relationship?
- Is spirituality important to you as a couple? If so, what spiritual traditions do you practice together?
- Do you have a community that supports your spiritual self-development and your family relationships?
- Was there ever a time in your life when you called on God for support?

Discovery Questions

Encourage more than a one-word answer.

- The biggest lesson on marriage I've learned from my parents is ___.
- I need to fight harder for ___ in my relationship.
- My relationship with God is ____.
- My views on love changed when ___.
- I'm most proud of my family/marriage for ___.
