Lisbon, Portugal—UPF and an affiliated organization, Women's Federation for World Peace (WFWP), were invited to participate in an awards ceremony honoring prominent Portuguese-speakers.

The singer Isabel Leitão, an Ambassador for Peace, along with two other WFWP Ambassadors for Peace, Dr. Mário Máximo and Hon. Paulo Pisco, invited UPF and WFWP to the third Lusofonia Awards Gala, which was held on October 19, 2019, in the Municipal Auditorium of Ruy de Carvalho.
