UPF and WFWP Lisbon, Portugal Leaders Attends Lusophone Parliament Meeting

Lisbon, Portugal -- The leaders of UPF and an affiliated organization joined officials of an international Lusophone organization in a meeting with members of parliament.

The national presidents of UPF and Women's Federation for World Peace (WFWP) accompanied Professor Alberto Araújo, an Ambassador for Peace and the president of PISCDIL (Plataforma Internacional da Sociedade Civil da Diáspora Lusófona), and the PISCDIL board. On February 18, 2020, the group met with a representative of the speaker of parliament, who is the president of the parliamentary delegation to the Parliamentary Assembly of the Community of Portuguese-Speaking Countries (CPLP).
