Mr.Dionesio Arcenas, Mr.Glenn Halipa and Mr.Michael Muega, from Iloilo Center, were the lecturers of the said seminar. It was a part of monthly seminar activity of the UM-Wester Visayas.

Aside from the monthly seminar are the series of seminar conducted every Saturday in the Iloilo Center.

Last Nov. 22 was the election of the officers of UPF in Brgy. Malublub, Badiangan, Iloilo. It was the follow-up activity of the Tribal Messiahship of Mrs. Marievic Mizushima last summer 2011. 30 members attended the election. The election was attended by Mrs. Rosela Cadile (CBF) and Iloilo Center Leader Mr. Jimson Muega as the UPF Regional office representatives. Mrs. Riza Tan was elected as the president of the cooperative.

There will be a 2-day meeting for the fulltime members of the movement on December 2-3, 2011 as an evaluation on the past month's accomplishments.
