The Open HoonDokHae is part of our JeonDo activities in Romania, and through it we want to spread True Parents words and culture for the young people and offer guidance for their life. Every two weeks we gather and read a small text together and then we share our understanding and opinion about it, encouraging the participants to reflect more deeply about their life.

Last Friday our topic for the Open HoonDokHae event was "Emotion, Intellect, Will" and the purpose was to guide the participants to realize about these three faculties of the mind and their role that they have in our development as human beings.

We started the meeting by each one of us introducing ourselves shortly, in order to know about each other and create a friendlier atmosphere. After we announced the topic of the meeting we divided in three groups and we read the material that we prepared, few passages from the Divine Principle and Unification Thought. Then we had around forty minutes to reflect about the message and discuss about it in the teams; each participant could share his own opinion and experience. Mainly we all agreed that although we have moments in witch we feel more guided by our emotions or by our intellect or by the power of will, we need to develop all of these three faculties of the mind and in this way bring an equilibrium in our life. One person gave an example that if we act just centered on our emotions, without asking ourselves if that act is also moral or centered on a principle that is true, then we do a mistake and we will suffer. So we concluded that a mature and happy person is one that can bring a balance between these three faculties of the mind and only like this we can achieve our goals.

These discussions also made us to ask ourselves more questions about our life, so we hope that each participant will continue to search for new ways to develop their intellectual side, understand and shape their emotions and create a strong will centered on goodness.
