

Rev. Kyeng Seuk Lu's biography

Rev. Kyeng Seuk Lu, current vice-president of Family Federation for World Peace and Unification (FFWPU) - Korea, will be inaugurated as the 16th president of FFWPU- Korea.

Rev. Lu graduated from Sun Moon University, majoring in Unification theology, and is studying for a Master's degree at the Unification Theological Seminary in the United States.



He was born in 1964 in Seoul, Korea. He started his career in ministry in October, 1991 as a religious worker in Yeosu, Korea and worked as a missionary to the Commonwealth of Independent States (CIS), leader of Guri Parish, the director of the Second Generation Department for FFWPU and director of planning bureau, etc.



Since 2008, he has worked as the director of the Tongil Group public affairs office, secretary general of the Universal Peace Federation and Strong Korea campaign and he served as vice-president of FFWPU-Korea since March, 2013.

He was born to a couple whose wedding was officiated by Rev. Sun Myung Moon and Hak Ja Han at the Joint-Wedding. It is the first time that a second generation Unificationist has become a president of FFWPU- Korea.
