He wanted to do it on camera. It was a great opportunity to witness about our love and respect for True Father so I agreed. Afterwards, all the members went to Holy Ground to give our prayers. More than ever, I felt True Father accepted my offering and asked to keep doing it, not because someone asks, but because we want to do it out of our love for Him.

That's why, when I was asked to come again to give the two-day seminar, I felt this had become a tradition.

I kept reiterating to them to go home, to pray and ask Jesus about this new revelation because Father received it from Jesus. They were from Ecuador which is where I was born also. Their sincere attitude really moved me. I also found out there was a doctor in the audience who was asking deep questions but was skeptical at the same time. He stayed till the very end of the workshop even though he had to catch a plane to Mexico.

I want to take this opportunity to thank God, True Parents and the Minneapolis church for allowing me to make this offering. Every time I have to teach Divine Principle, persecution begins from family and from everywhere to try to stop me. I even got sick this time.
