As a part of the third group of Cheon II Guk missionaries, I went to Nepal for a year. Having returned to Japan, I am now dedicated to church work in the Tokushima Family Church. He easily said he wanted to attend the workshop, since it was on a day he was off work. In this unexpected situation, all I could do was pray, asking God, Why did you give me this person when I am lacking in conditions and not filled with enough love?

In talking with Mr. Abe, I learned that his mother had died when he was young and he had never been able to experience a mother's love. Afterward, witnessing did not go well at times and difficult times arose for other reasons, but during those days, I was also able to meet a nineteen- year-old university freshman, Mr. Tanaka. Like Mr. Abe, when I introduced the church to him, Mr. Tanaka said right away, "I want to go." Once he started summer vacation, he began to go to the church two or three times a week. We would study Divine Principle and talk. As we talked, I felt there were many things about which we had similar thoughts and that we had experienced some of the same pains of the heart. I felt that God had prepared him to meet me. I realized I had gone through those difficulties in the past so I could understand Mr. Tanaka's heart at this time. I was grateful for those difficulties, and through this experience, I felt I too had received salvation.

Through meeting these two guests, I was able to feel God's great love and learn many things. Everything I had gone through had been necessary and this forty-day period was a precious treasure through which I walked with tears and laughter together with God. I strongly felt that God prepares the people we meet and the path we take. God, the parent of all humanity, wishes for each person's happiness. He wishes all to be happy.
