Radio Nigeria, the federal government nationwide radio has approved our proposal to teach Divine Principle, True Family Values, Peace Education and Community Development Project on the network of Radio Nigeria covering all 36 states and the Federal Capital Territory.

The radio program is to be called the Voice of Teachers program and will be aired every week for 13 weeks from May - August 2024 at the cost of N205,000 per week which is equivalent to:

- \$170 per week
- £150 per week
- €160 per week

To start the program which can be listened to on air and online, we need to pay for 13 weeks first.

This is one key national level foundation that we are laying and this can be instrumental to many other national and nationwide achievements.
