I was recently matched and blessed by True Parents Benjy Uyama May 2011

Hey everyone,

As many of you know, I was recently matched and blessed by True Parents. In brief, my spouse is Hitoe Suzaki; she is Japanese, but we converse in Korean; she is 20 years-old and is studying Unification Theology at Sunmoon University. She sings in a band called "Rebirth" that plays Hyo Jin nim's music.

The whole matching and Blessing experience was incredible, from when I arrived in Korea on October 3rd, until I left on the 15th.

I spent 3 days in Cheong Pyeong before the matching workshop, which began on the 6th, to prepare my heart and mind. After those three days of intense prayer and reflection I felt completely clear and ready for whatever Father had in store for me (hehe).

The matching workshop started on the 6th with lectures and testimonies of other match couples. On the night of the 6th, it was announced that Father will hold the matching the next day. The next day came and I could feel how ready everyone was; there was an immense sense of trust in God and True Parents from each if the matching candidates; but of course, we were all nervous.

We got to the palace and sat down in a room, where we waited for about 10 to 20 minutes before True Parents came. True Father first wanted to break the ice with some singing. Three brothers volunteered to sing. They were pretty good. Then Father started pointing to people in the crowd to get up and sing; it turned out they could all sing really well. It was nice to see how keen Father still is. After the singing finished, he told everyone to put their hands in the air. "Put your hands together and don't look at them" he said. "Now look at them... If your left thumb is above your right thumb, stand up. Everyone else go to the back of the room." By doing this, Father split the brothers' group and the sisters' group almost perfectly in half, so that there were a total of four groups: two brothers' and two sisters' groups. Then Father started to say, "You should all be able to take responsibility and find your own spouse. You should be able to completely follow your Original Mind and find a spouse for yourselves. I should ask you to find your own spouse, shouldn't I?" We all laughed at his joke....but he was not joking. At this point, we all thought he was kidding and he was just getting us ready before he stared matching us. Then he kept talking about it more, and more.

I was third in line to go look at the sisters and I remember standing there with my eyes closed, asking God, "What kind of person is good for me? What qualities should I look for in a spouse? What do I look for?!" The brothers next to me already went to look at the sisters, but I did not move. I remember just standing there in prayer. Then, all of a sudden, True Father said something that made everything SO clear to me. He said, "Don't look at just the face; look at her heart. Look at everything" At that moment I was overcome with a tremendous feeling of confidence and faith in God. Finally, I began looking. I looked carefully, but briefly, at each sister. By the time I went through all of them, I closed my eyes and tried to remember each person that I saw. But I could only remember one face: Hitoe Suzaki.

Then, out of nowhere, Daemon nim pops out of nowhere with a HUGE smile on her face, pushing Hitoe from behind, saying, "Go, go, go!"

We left the room together and the first thing I said to her was, "Are you Japanese?" (In Japanese). She got really excited for a second because she thought I spoke Japanese, but I didn't. But when we found out we both speak Korean, we were so relieved.

After the first few awkward minutes, we began to realize that we had a lot in common. She is good friends with my brother's spouse, Yigyu; we both love music; we both want to teach the DP and educate 2nd and 3rd Gen. Despite our similarities, we are very different in character.
