

# Leadership Development Assembly

San Marino, Italy, 25. – 26. October 2014

They received a large majority of votes. In their speech they promised to continue to invest as much as they predecessors did and to take care of the young members and 2nd gen. with all their hearts. Especially felt was the need to be united and work together more and more.
