For those nations in which social gathering is restricted or not permitted due to the coronavirus pandemic, please consider other options such as an online or outdoor service. Please be sure to follow local government guidelines and take care to protect yourself and others. Please note the following guidelines:

Name of Event: Celebration of the 58th Day of All True Things

Date and Time: The celebration should be held at 7:00 a.m. (local time), or at a time designated by the national leader, on Sunday, 5.1 by the Heavenly Calendar in the eighth year of Cheon II Guk (June 21, 2020).

Venue: The celebration should be held in in each country's main chapel and in regional and local churches if possible, but otherwise according to the situation in your country.

Fruit, cake and other items can be prepared for a Holy Day offering table, according to the circumstances of the local church.
