Mrs. Kobayashi was in the Education Department in 1975 in Barrytown, NY. She, together with Kathy Novalis, Diane Fernsler, and Tim Elder, worked very hard to learn the history and origin of each song. They had to translate many of the songs from their original language. The lyrics we sing in Holy Songs today have undergone several refining translations. But in this manual we are hoping that the holy song histories will allow readers to understand the deeply spiritual roots of our church's early days.

Holy Songs were received through spirit world during deep prayer. Each song expresses the heart of Heavenly Father who has been suffering to construct the path of our restoration course. On our own, our infant spirits cannot possibly comprehend Heavenly Father's six thousand year course of walking the way of indemnity. These songs will have a profound effect upon our lives of faith if we strive to know the heart of each song, and use them to teach ourselves by retracing the course of restoration. The way of restoration through indemnity is the restoration of the heart. Through these Holy Songs we can come to know the heart of Jesus and the heart of True Parents. Many aspects of God's Heart throughout restoration can be understood: His anger, joy, sorrow, and happiness. By singing these songs, our spirits will be opened to infinite new worlds and we will be able to unite with God's personality in all of its full beauty. We should sing them not just to fulfill our own desires, but in deep, sincere prayer. This attitude will enable us to receive spiritual nourishment from them.

Due to the lack of research, many Holy Songs still remain to be translated, and the explanations of the meanings and backgrounds of Holy Songs are not complete. I intend to continue my study so that Heaven's Heart contained in Holy Songs can be told more accurately and more deeply, and so that we can construct a new tradition of Holy Songs.

(Editor's Note: Holy Songs were originally introduced in America in 1975, after a significant three year period of growth and accomplishment. These songs helped us to deeply appreciate the message and depth of heart of our Heavenly Father. There is vast spiritual depth in the history and background of these songs—each one could easily become a lesson in Principle and the Heart of God. When sung sincerely, each song can raise the atmosphere and drive evil away. While singing these songs, we should feel ourselves in a meeting with True Parents, for they contain the essence of our Father's words and love. We should search for Father in the words, and sing his life-blood into our very souls. We should be deeply grateful for the intense prayer and effort required to translate these songs into English.

1. Blessing of Glory

3. New Song of Inspiration

Words: Rev. Sun Myung Moon, 1947 Music: Duk Chin Kim

"Inspiration" in this song means the encouragement from God pushing Father with all of his might, urging him on as he walks his course of winning God's words. Father expresses his intense desire to unravel the Word, even at the cost of his life. Father commands himself with a great sense of responsibility: he must be determined to overcome death and find God's Words.

After Father uncovers the truth, voices of all spirit world ring joyously through the heavens at the news that the building of a new Eden will begin. The. word "new" appears throughout this song. All of history until now has been under Satanic dominion. After 6000 years, history begins anew with the Lord of the Second Advent. Everything related to the Lord of the Second Advent is new. "A day of bright new life" refers to the Messiah's life and the lives of those who follow him. Living a life of righteousness to obtain the purpose of goodness, should become the standard of the new Heavenly order.

We cannot fully understand how difficult it was to battle for God's Word. Father cried out with tears and sweat "This must be Your will! But Satan can accuse, so You can't answer me even though You want to, can You?" Mr. Eu shared Father's words explaining the difficulty of discovering the Word: "Imagine a completely dark night, a night like the whole sky has been covered by a tent. And imagine a light like a pin-hole in the canvas. Unveiling the Principle is about as difficult as it would be to strike that light with only one attempt."

6. Song of the Victors

Words: Rev. Sun Myung Moon 1957 Music: Duk Chin Kim

Around 1956-1957, many members would become spiritual during worship services. At the time Father would preach the sermon himself and often wore the traditional white dress of Korea. This melody was arranged by Miss Kim from a melody that a 60 year old woman began singing shen she became spiritual during service. Before being rearranged, the rhythm was far more distinctively Korean. It is unsure whether Father wrote the words before or after the melody existed.

7. Song of the Spring Breeze

Words: Rev. Sun Myung Moon Music: Traditional Korean Song

When Father was in prison, he never wanted to burden Heavenly Father with his condition because he was the one who was to bring the eternal springtime. His imprisonment prevented him from telling the people. To encourage himself, he would always think of the future. One day he heard another prisoner singing this song. Father began to sing it himself every day. Later, Father said to the Family, "You don't know how much

inspiration and comfort I received from singing this." Although it is a simple melody, he imparted a deeper meaning to it.

When singing this song, it is important to remember how harsh Korean winters are; Koreans anticipate spring more eagerly than most people. Poetically, the powers of winter (Satan) attack us with cold winds and icy snow that hurts like needles. But spring (Lord of the Second Advent) will come with sweet fragrances and chase winter away. The Korean peninsula has suffered a long nightmare. The time has come for us to be released from this suffering. The butterfly and meadowlark not only represent spring, but also the people who have received the Word and have come to life. We should sing this song paying close attention to the imagery used.

This is a hymn from the established Korean Christian churches. It describes how a dark and lonely soul comes across the love of Christ, is resurrected by that love, and is inspired to spread that love to other people. The first verse is sung with the spirit of a sinner who has looked into his own heart, reflected on his life course, and suddenly discovered that God has been at his side all this time.

This song is a Korean Unification Church song. We sing this song in tears of deep joy of receiving the Lord of the Second Advent. It is unclear who first began singing it. The Korean people, like the Israelites, have suffered throughout their history. But now, Korea has been chosen as the country to receive the long-awaited Lord of the Second Advent.

Words and music: Hyo Min Eu, 1956

Mr. Eu is a cousin of the late President Eu. He composed this song during a time when the media was attacking the Church severely. One of Father's sermons inspired the feeling of trusting Father completely and to be an obedient offering. It was a time when many failed to make complete offerings of themselves and fell by the wayside. In his sermon, Father tearfully preached, "I want you all to die with me!" Heavenly Father must always put the weakest ones at the very front and urge them to complete His Providence, even though they may fall ten thousand times. Heavenly Father has only one way to advance His Providence, through sacred offerings. Searching for those sacred offerings He has kept the altar ready, lacking only the offering. Heavenly Father must have cried so much, not being able to tell anyone about His sad and mournful heart! Thinking of Heavenly Father's heart in this way, Father wept. When Mr. Eu saw these tears he expressed his own tearful heart and deep determination in the lines of this song.

This is a Korean Unification Church song and is based on a powerful sermon of abundant hope that Father gave. According to Mr. Eu this is a condensation of that sermon. Let's set the foundation of peace in the new heaven and new earth where we are never accused by Satan. There we can sing praises with all of our heart from within the heart of our True Father.

The desire for the restoration of the universe mounts toward its climax along with the melody.

Chase away the power of Satan, far away beyond the land and sea; Build for God a boundless Kingdom, giving joy and liberty to all. Come, ye people all around the world, let's unit into one; Spreading forth the glory of the Father, and His great will forevermore.

12. Song of the Young People

Words: Kwang Yol Yoo, 1955 Music: Duk Chin Kim

When the Young People's Fellowship was founded in early 1955, Mr. Yoo wrote this song to fill a need for songs written with young people in mind. A contest was held for the best melody, and the winning melody is the one we sing today. Mr. Yoo explained this song is connected to Handel's writing of the Messiah. One night Handel was having difficulty in organizing the melody, so he drew his thick drapes and began sleeping in a

chair. When he awoke and opened the curtains, the bright morning sun rushed into the room, as if to dispel the darkness there. The bright glare of the morning light immediately cleared his confusion, and the light of inspiration rushed into his heart. He completed the Messiah in a record time of 25 days. Like the light that was given to Handel, a powerful light rends the curtains of the darkness of 6000 years to dispel the long darkness of our history.

We shout with joy, we rise and sing! The Will of God is done! A new day dawns and the dream lives; the Son of God has come! Fight bravely to crush Satan; God's power will be revealed. In the children of our Father, the Youth of Harmony.

The darkness which has covered us in Him has been dispelled. The dawn breaks into daylight; we ring the morning bell. Thirty billion shall live in the bright white light of truth. Let us rise and march forward with Harmony of Youth.

This song was composed to comfort and encourage members who had been sent out to pioneer the countryside. Taegu is a town with a good educational system and has many fervent Christians. Partly because of this, the opposition here was extreme.

Around 1965 some members walked a long distance to partially retrace the course Father had gone before when he walked from Pyong Yang to Pusan. This ten day march was very difficult for these members. Their feet became swollen, their ;bodies tired; but even in this hardship, they sang this song to keep persevering until every one of them completed the course.

Initially, this song was used during entertainment hours. Later it was included among the Holy Songs.

Mrs. Kamiyama was sent on one of the first pioneering missions in Japan. She was sent to Nagoya where Mrs. Matsumoto, and later Mrs. Kasuga, established a church center. Christians there had been warned not to listen to the missionaries and persecution intensified until it developed into bloodshed. Even Christians who had heard the principle disappeared.

In the Moriyama section of Nagoya, there was an old woman who had been instructed in a vision to build a kindergarten and wait for a certain person to appear. When she met Mrs. Matsumoto, she knew this was the person she had been expecting. She gave the missionaries her building to use as a church. But as the persecution became more intense, she gradually became negative and took the missionaries to court, having told many lies about them. In court, the old woman during her testimony began confessing all the abuse she had given them. The court stated that she should be the one on trial.

<u>Song of Victory</u> was received during this persecution. The missionaries were praying when Jesus appeared and said, "You who are chosen must love the Lord of the Second Advent more than anyone, even me. Love him and serve him. He has testified to my suffering and sorrow. He has given his love to me and now you must love him."

Jesus spoke about his life, testifying to his heart as he had entered Jerusalem: "As I entered Jerusalem, I had two feelings within me. First I rejoiced in the thought that I could establish God's Will that I could be the King of kings. But I also worried that one among them might betray me. I had to struggle between these feelings. You cannot fathom how much I cried when it happened as I had feared, and no one would

believe. I grieved over the sight of men who would sing Hosannas one moment, but quickly reverse their hearts." The missionaries were in tears. Suddenly, the missionaries and spirit world began singing this song.

A prison guard pulled them by the chain and led them through the crowd. The press swarmed around them and cameras were flashing all around. It was just as if a murderer had been arrested.

This holy song has very mysterious origins. It has existed in Korea for a long time but also it has been a favorite folk hymn in the Appalachian Mountains for 100 years or more. One possible explanation is that English pioneers brought it to America while English missionaries took the same song to Korea. In July, 1967, when Father went to Japan, he decided to sing this song during his lecture and explained the significance of the words:

As the world changes from Satan's dominion to God's dominion, the Lord will come. The lilies represent the bride. Even though the wind may blow from all directions, their fragrance always goes in one direction because of their shape. You should study the lilies and pray that you can be more like them. When the Lord showers His grace upon us, dead hearts are revived, and we see and hear the world from a completely different viewpoint. Pure spring water runs over the ground purifying the ground. Our minds and bodies are so filthy, but they are purified and become fertile ground. The 6,000 year-revenge is taken, and this world becomes the flower garden of the Kingdom of God. The indemnity of the cross must be wiped away by going the reverse course. The Lord comes by the cross: Jesus by the red cross, and the Lord of the Second Advent by the white cross. When that indemnity has been restored, mankind can enter the Kingdom of Heaven. We build the Kingdom of Heaven ourselves. To this end we must suffer much more than we have until now. But it will enable us to win true victory. Suffering that took place in the past was washed away as indemnity. But suffering in the Completed Testament Age will bear fruit and become our glory. In this glorious time, we must shoulder His Providence to rebuild the Kingdom of Heaven and follow.
