The event takes place Friday, September 21 - 23, 2018. Arrival time is between 7:30 pm and 11 pm on Friday or after 8am Saturday. Departure time is 9:30 am Sunday. Click here to sign up online.

No registration is guaranteed until fee is paid in full. We reserve the right to delete any registration that is not paid for by September 18. After September 18, all fees must be paid at the time of registration.

Refunds

A refund fee is necessary due to transaction costs and commitments made by the camp based on the number of attendees. We try to keep it as low as possible to accommodate guests with extenuating circumstances that require them to withdraw from camp.

If notified by email at registrar@shehaquafamily.org up to 5 days before the registered program starts, we will issue a refund minus a 5% cancellation fee. After that, if notified up to the day before the registered program starts, we will issue a refund minus a 10% cancellation fee. Those not showing up will not receive a refund.
