

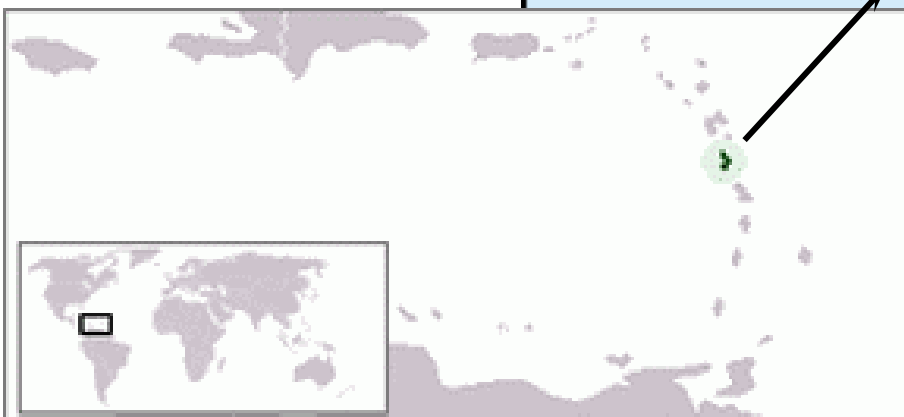
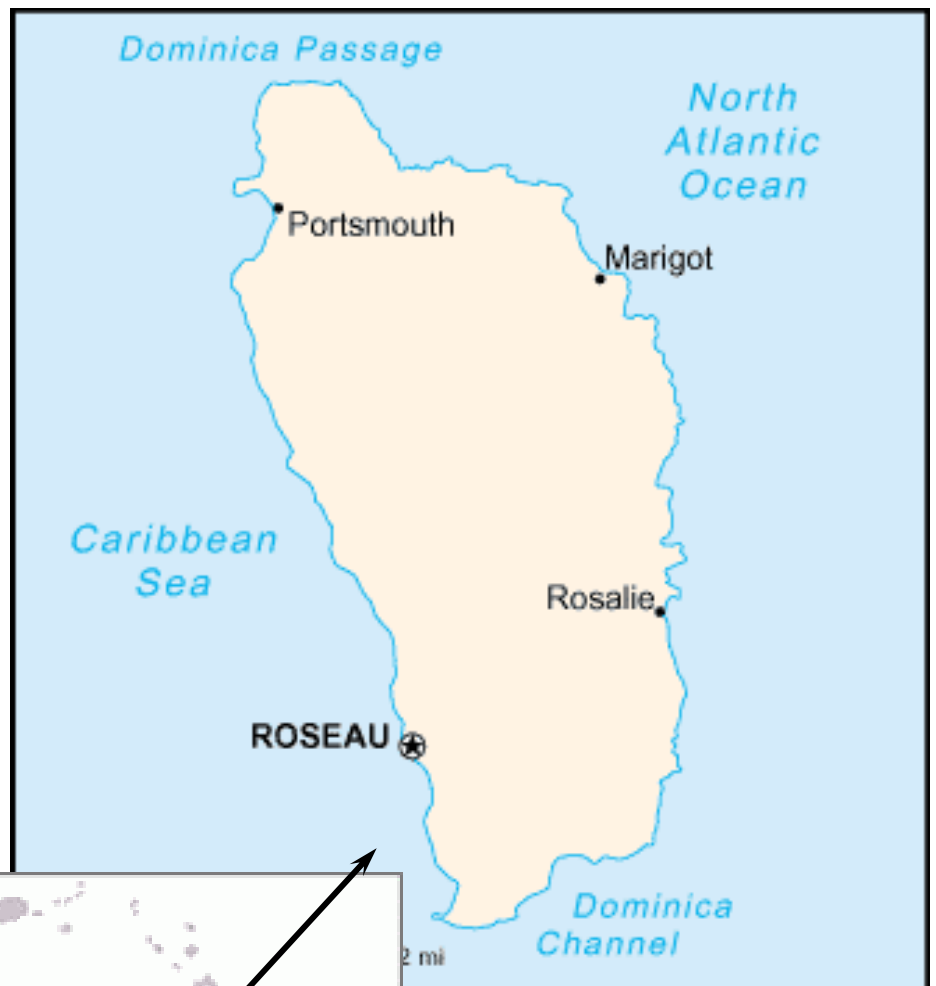

Over 80 guests including Ambassadors for Peace and ministers of government, old friends and new contacts gathered at the Garraway Hotel in Roseau for the main rally of the 3rd World Tour, God's Ideal Family and Peace Kingdom in Dominica.

Our program began with opening remarks by emcee, Ms. Irma Lafond-Joseph, and was followed by the invocation and the singing of the National Anthem. Minister for Public Works and Public Utilities and member of Parliament, Hon. Ambrose George, gave welcome remarks. He praised the work of the UPF and offered his support. Hon. Matthew Walter, Minister of Community Development, Information and Gender Affairs, stated in his welcome remarks that the intentions and the work of UPF and its staff in Dominica and around the world were genuine and honest and were to be applauded and given full support.

Steve Mudgett, Director of UPF in Dominica, followed with the reading of the Chairman's Address and then the video, "A Giant Step toward World Peace" was shown. All the guests were moved by the breadth of the work of the Founders of UPF, True Father and True Mother and their whole three-generation family.

After a brief introduction, Shiori Kunitoki gave the main address. She gave the address in clearly-spoken English and impressed the guests with her youthful charm, gracious beauty, and warm smile.

The second part of the program began with the Holy Wine ceremony. All participants freely took the Holy Wine and then the Holy Water and answered loudly, "Yes," to the Blessing vows and shared in the Blessing prayer and declaration. We presented over fifty Ambassador for Peace certificates.

The Program was concluded with the presentation of flowers to Shiori Nim and three rousing cheers of Ok Mansei by Ambassador of Peace, Mr. Michael Royer.

After the speech and Blessing event, we moved to the Fort Young Hotel across the street for a victory dinner and cake cutting. All sang a joyful "Happy Victory to Shiori Nim" while Shiori and Mr. Julien Prevost and his wife, Pearl, cut the victory cake. Dinner began with a very positive show of support by Mr. Prevost. Mr. Prevost said he looked to the day when the Father Moon would be offered the red carpet entrance to Dominica and thanked Father Moon for his help and guidance to Dominicans through the serious and positive network of the UPF.

This late evening celebration took the place of the usual morning gathering because Shiori Nim had to leave very early the next day to return to Korea.

Dominica was the last speech and Blessing event given by Shiori during this 3rd World Tour. She had visited a total of 30 countries to share God's words and Blessing.

We are very grateful we could welcome a member of the True Family for the first time ever since our work began here in 1996. Ten Japanese volunteers devoted their heart and effort to make Shiori comfortable and happy, and she moved the heart of all the guests with their sincerity and joyful service.
