

# Women as Ambassador for Peace

On the occasion of 8<sup>th</sup> of march, International Day of Women, Tirana

In a very festive atmosphere, in the hall of Peace Embassy, Tirana, WFWP, UPF and CARP organised a joint program on 8th of march titled "Woman, as Ambassador for Peace".



After the welcoming remarks, the moderator Marjeta Rroshi presented the different activities that WFWP organised during the year 2011, concluding with the recent project titled "Clean your cupboard and help the poor families", which was a help to some families with orphaned children. This project was coordinated by Mrs. Natalia Colomoiets, and longed 15 days. It started with the preparation of posters and leaflets that were distributed in the area of our HQ offices. The answer of the people was very positive, even the time of call was very short.

In total we could get 50 bags of clothes, from which 44 was distributed to families with only mothers, and 6 bags, with baby clothes were given to an orphanage managed by Mother Teresa sisters in Elbasan, together with some baby food donated by WFWP Japan. The Chairman of organisation who received the donations read a thankful message to all the participants for this initiative and support.





After that the program continued with a message given from Mrs. Kozeta Tavalani, UPF Chairman, Tirana, who also celebrated her birthday on this day. Between her speech, she mentioned that "As I was born on 8<sup>th</sup> of march, I feel a special mission to promote the rights of women. 8<sup>th</sup> of march is well known as international day of women, as a day who serves not only to unite women of any race, religion, culture, language, and background, but also to remember the effort for equality and peace.

According to Holy Scriptures, the women was created by the man's ribs, and not from the legs to be violated, and not from the head to be higher than man.
