You are cordially invited to attend the Ambassadors for Peace Americas Tour 2010: Guatemala, which will be held from July 17th-23rd in Guatemala.

The Ambassadors for Peace Americas Tour is a seven-day service and fact-finding tour on the subject theme: "Breaking Barriers, Building Bridges: The Need for Hemispheric Cooperation." The purpose of the tour is to foster cooperation and unity of the American hemisphere by building partnerships and friendships among Ambassadors for Peace from North and South America.

The tour is sponsored by the Universal Peace Federation, the Family Federation for World Peace and Unification-Guatemala, and Sun International Peace Federation.

The tour includes two seminars for Ambassadors for Peace, which will be on the subject: "Breaking Barriers, Building Bridges: The Need for Hemispheric Cooperation". The seminars will be held in Guatemala City and in Santiago Atitlan. The tour also includes a service component, and visits to points of interest, such as Antigua, Mayan ruins at Ximiche, and the Black Sand Beach.

The registration fee is \$875 for single occupancy and \$775 for double occupancy (a couple or four participants sharing a room). The registration fee includes five nights hotel accommodations, meals, ground transportation, and entrance fees to points of interest. The registration fee does not include airfare.

Participants must be of good health, since the tour has a full schedule, distance travel, and the town of Santiago Atitlan is located two hours from the nearest hospital.
