Miyazaki Ken, Kagoshima Ken and Kumamoto Ken's Blessed Members were very fortunate to be the first prefecture visited by the First Vice- Minister of the Philippine Unification Church Ministry in Japan, the Honorable Western Japan Regional Minister Rafael Enriquez Ablong.



Minister Rafael E. Ablong had arrived in Miyako City Bus Terminal at exactly 5:35 p.m. on Saturday afternoon. This was his first footstep in this prefecture. The next day, Sunday April 11th, we woke up before 6:00 am for our morning service. Rev. Ablong led the service. We read True Father's speeches for our Hoon Dok Hae. It was followed by our breakfast and preparation to go to the venue.



The venue of our gathering is at Miyazaki Municipal Cultural Hall. The pictures below are the participants. It was changed later to COMMANDO then now we have the newly organized group of Philippine blessed members, the PHILIPPINE UNIFICATION CHURCH MINISTRY in JAPAN. He also explained the vision and how all blessed families living in Japan are working hard in order to realize that vision.
