#### **Session 1: Introduction**



Why get married? Why stay married? This interactive

session invites people to contribute their responses and promotes a vision of the family as the school of love. Research findings on the benefits of marriage to both the couple and their children are introduced and discussed.

Session 3: Family as a School of Love and Peace

#### **Option A**

**Presentation:** Family as a School of Love and Peace The family is the primary human institution and is considered sacred by religions throughout the world. The World Peace Blessing is introduced as a public commitment to honoring the oneness of the human family.

**Session 4: Building Better Family Relationships**

#### Presentation: Really Listening

In this session we introduce some tried and true listening structures that promote empathy, deeper understanding, and emotional safety. These skills are practiced in this session so the participant can get a sense of how to bring these skills home to spark better connections.
