First time Unification Church Andorra can participate with UNESCO Andorra in exhibition in the Annual Andorra Fair

This Fair is a meeting place for exhibitors and visitors which occupies a 12,000-square-metre area and can accommodate more than 150 exhibitors, who come both from Andorra and beyond, and are engaged in a multitude of sectors, including tourism, leisure, sport, recreation, the motor industry, commerce and food and drink, and represent public and private institutions, organisations, associations and so on.

UNESCO in Andorra has been working with all different religions to help them be able to register officially with the

Government but so far, this goal is not achieved yet. Therefore, this year, for the first time, UNESCO in Andorra organized to have its exhibition booth for Interreligious group, showing the existence of other religions in the nation.

We, as Unification Church was invited to participate and exhibit our church materials together with other religions' materials.

We displayed Divine Principle in Spanish, French and Portuguese language, True Father's Autobiography in 4 languages including Catalan the official language, 2 Hour Divine Principle lecture, True

There are around 70,000 people visited this Fair each year.

On the opening day the Chief of the Government & the Capital's Mayor of Andorra visited all the booths.

It was the beginning and good opportunity for other non-official religions in Andorra to be able to show their existence in Andorra because the official and the only

religion in Andorra is Roman Catholics and there is no law for the Government to change this situation. Under UNESCO Andorra, we will have meetings and do something together more in the future.
