## ACLC NJ celebrates its first annual True Family Values Banquet in Paterson

Manoj Jacob of the Clifton Family Church, explained the history of the True Family Values Ministry, which originated 23 years ago in Chicago under the leadership of Dr. Ki Hoon Kim, Regional Chairman of Family Federation North America, and the inspiration of True Parents. Rev. Jacob announced that New Jersey and the surrounding states strive to develop and expand the True

Family Values Ministry through annual banquets and awards ceremonies which promote The Marriage Blessing Ceremony. Rev. Jacob aims to improve the quality of life, relationships in the community and beyond by promoting the idea that we should all live for the sake of others.
