Conference at the “BÈ COMMUNITY CENTER”

On January 9th, 2016 we held the conference for religious and community leaders at Bè community center, a popular district of Lomé. We had 26 participants.

The event began with the welcoming address by the MC, Mr. Ebenezer ADUFULI, which was followed by address from the President of FFWPU Togo, Reverend KOUSSOUGBO Sassou. In his address, he emphasized strongly that True families are to heal the world, and invited the participants to join the activities of Intercultural and interfaith blessings for peace in order to save the Togolese nation and the world. After the speech we had time for Q&A.

At the end of discussions, participants expressed their regret at not having known earlier about these lessons so full of life and hope for our society in crisis.

After the conference the Chief has received, congratulated and encouraged the delegation to keep the family values in their daily life.
