

SunHak History Institute: Our beloved brother, Miguel Angel Cano Jimenez has ascended

Our beloved brother, Dr. Miguel Angel Cano Jiménez, a former national leader of Spain and a member of the SunHak Institute of History Committee representing Spain, who played a crucial role in recording providential history, was diagnosed with cancer in the spring of this year and ascended to the Spirit World on June 29, 2023. The Seonghwa Ceremony was held on July 1, 2023.

Dr. Miguel Cano was born in 1950, and in 1971 he was the first person in Spain to join the Family Federation. He remained a faithful member all his life. In 1978, he got married in the 118-couple Blessing Ceremony in London to Françoise Ansoult from France, and he led the Family Federation of Spain from 1990 to 1993. He felt the need to understand the teachings and their origin more deeply, therefore, he went to South Korea for two years (1993-1995), where he studied Korean language and culture, as well as the Family Federation's teachings in depth in their original language. He was deeply inspired and decided to study philosophy.

He received his doctorate in 2003 from the National University of Distance Learning (UNED). His thesis received the highest possible rating of "Summa Cum Laude" and was awarded the PhD Extraordinary Award, given to the three most relevant PhD theses of the academic year. He mentioned that the structure of the thesis came from Unification Thought. Later, his thesis got published in three volumes, and the series was called Foundations of Peace Education (Science and Values, Global Ethical Consensus, Ethics and Peace). Cano's mentor, José Maria Quintana Cabanas (1930-2013), senior professor of the Department of Social Pedagogy of the Education Faculty at the UNED, wrote a review of the books in the Spanish Journal of Education. The books were acquired by many Spanish universities.

From 2006 to 2016, Miguel Cano worked as a professor of philosophy in public schools in Malaga, Spain.

Moreover, he was deeply aware of the importance of collecting materials related to the missionary history of Spain. Therefore, after he retired in 2016, he dedicated himself to this important work. The History Committee in Spain was established, and he started collecting various materials such as pictures, documents, videos, reports, and newspapers. Through his dedicated work, he collected almost 2TB of detailed materials from the past until the year 2020.

Moreover, he wrote his autobiography, which also became a foundation for faith and spiritual education for members. He also helped the former National Leaders of Spain, Mr. Elio and Brunhilde d'Alberti, write their own autobiographies and dedicated himself to collecting testimonies from early members.

In January 2018, he published an 8-volume series titled "Universal Principles to Build a Culture of Peace" in Spanish and English, and in October 2019, he published a new trilogy titled "Universal Values and Principles to Create a Culture of the Heart."

He did not only publish valuable publications but also organize meetings with teachers and educators in Spain to teach them the contents of his books.

After establishing the World History Committee in 2019, he actively contacted the staff and was appointed to join the endeavors in June 2021. He completed the records of missionary history in Spain until November 2022.

As a member of the SunHak History Institute World History Committee, he donated many missionary historical materials and committed himself to officially recording Spanish missionary history so that the vast amount of data he collected during the years could remain forever in a public institution for future generations. In addition, he found errors among the existing records and corrected them through discussions and finding the evidence together with the SunHak History Institute. Without a doubt, he invested much time and effort to ensure the Spanish missionary records were accurate.

During his commitment and hard work, he had strong support from his Korean daughter-in-law, Moon Ji-ae. She understood the importance of her father-in-law's mission and proposed to take responsibility for translating the Spanish records into Korean, and she helped him with other difficulties that occurred while striving to accomplish his task (communication with the Korean SunHak Institute of History, using a computer, etc.).

He was a Spanish philosopher and thinker, PhD from 2003 in philosophy and educational sciences, and author who left a real treasure of books on peace. At the same time, he was the first person in Spain to join the **Family Federation**, then called the **Unification Church**, in 1971 and remained a faithful member all his life.


He was born in Madrid in 1950, got married in a large **Family Federation** wedding in London in 1978 to Françoise Ansout from France, and led the **Family Federation** of Spain from 1990 to 1993.

In order to understand the teachings and their origin more deeply, Miguel Cano spent two years (1993-1995) in South Korea, where he studied Korean language and culture, as well as the **Family Federation's** teachings in depth in their original language. He was struck, and deeply moved, by how clear, logical and deep the insights were, which he gained during that time. It was then that he got the inspiration to study philosophy at a university, obtain a PhD and devote himself to teaching.

He received his doctorate in 2003 from National University of Distance Learning (UNED). His thesis received the highest possible rating "Summa Cum Laude" and was awarded the PhD Extraordinary Award, given to the three most relevant PhD thesis of the academic year.

Cano said that he got the idea for the structure of the thesis quite early during his doctorate courses. The inspiration for the content came from **Unification Thought**, published by Dr. Sang-hun Lee, an early disciple of **Sun Myung Moon**. Javier Muguerza (1936-2019), one of the most prestigious authorities in Moral Philosophy in Spain, read Cano's draft carefully and told him that his writings were organized as a Hegelian philosophical system that was intended to cover all fields of knowledge.




1. Original Human Nature: Sacred, Unique, Eternal and Cosmic Value


