# Russia

#### Improvement of Family Relations Seminar by Professor Oh

Blessed families – healthy in spirit, full of love, capable of solving conflicts, fulfilling their tribal messiah's role, serving Heavenly Parent and humanity - this is our most hope and our goal to become. With that vision Northeast region of Unification movement has launched the new year.

In the beginning of new year of 2015 Northeast Region held special seminars for members and blessed families to make a new start in their life and missions. For that program Northeast Regional HQ has invited professor of psychology Oh Gyu Yong from Sun-Moon University. The program named "Improvement of Family Relations" was held in Khabarovsk (Far East), Moscow (Central Russia) and St. Petersburg (North-West Russia) from Decemeber 29, 2014 to January 9, 2015. About 150 participants – blessed couples and single members had attended this program. One of the seminars in Moscow - the longest one - was designed to train church leaders and family counsellors to help blessed families and church community solve more effectively difficulties and challenges they meet. Counsellors and leaders received new tools to make lives more harmonious and full of love.

## Mongolia

#### **UPA students' Field Education**

Three first-year course students of Universal Peace Academy (UPA) came to Mongolia and participated in the front line education program from January 4 till February 15.

One student is originally from Mongolia. He participated in the program at her homeland, and two Filipinos from the everlasting summer country faced great challenge to live in the coldest capital in the world.

Their main training is witnessing activity. Following a Mongolian method of using multi-media, they show university students an introduction video to the Divine Principle on the street.

UPA students also have had cultural experiences. Riding horse is a major taste of traditional Mongolian nomadic life style.







Mongolia Church organized two 7-day workshops for CARP core members: during December 24-30 there were 5 participants, and the workshop on January 06-12 was attended by 9. Participants reviewed Divine Principle and True Parent's course. They also learned about individual formula course in life of faith, in order to be ready to join 21-days fundraising activity.

UPA students also introduced their dance culture to the Mongolian participants, and they showed a dance which they enjoyed together in attendance to True Mother.



# Ukraine

On January 1, 2015 blessed families from Kyiv gathered together in the workshop center near Kyiv to celebrate the New Year. There were altogether more than 80 people. We spend a good time together. Children enjoyed all kind of games together with their parents. It was a great opportunity to establish close relations between our blessed families and all the members who truly enjoyed this time.

## Workshop for the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> generation

On January 9-11, we held a special educational workshop for older children of the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> generation. 10 children participated in the event. We discussed many important issues, such as: life of faith, our attitude to the Movement, our goals and vision for the future.



On January 12-14, we held a 3-day DP workshop for our  $2^{nd}$  generation. Nineteen children aged 7 - 12 attended the workshop. Our educational program included DP lectures, games, contests, and sports competitions. Our older  $2^{nd}$  generation children gave some lectures. It was a good experience for them.

On January 15-21, 2015, we held a 7-day Divine Principle workshop in Kyiv. Five new guests attended the workshop. All participants were inspired by studying the Divine Principle. They expressed their desire to continue their education in our Movement.

#### **Blessing workshop and Matching**



On January 23-25 we held a Blessing workshop. Among the participants were all Ukrainian members; we also had a few guests from Russia and one from Albania. All together there were over 100 participants. Our elder members gave testimonies about their Blessing and family life. Young members listened very attentively and asked many questions. After that, our national messiah together with elder members conducted the Matching ceremony. Five new couples were matched. All members shared that it was a great experience for them to participate in this workshop. We all got a strong feeling of being one big family.

#### Leaders' meeting

On January 26, we held a meeting for the witnessing center leaders in Kyiv. There were 18 participants. Leaders shared about the problems in their centers; during the discussion that followed we tried to find the best solutions. After that, we had sports competition for the center leaders. Winners received some financial award for their center. Leaders went back to their mission cities with a new determination to invest in God's Will.

#### **Unity Festival**

On January 22, 2015 WFWP-Ukraine took part in the All-Ukrainian international Unity Festival "Embrace, Ukraine!" The event was related to the Ukraine Unity Day. Over 2000 people attended the festive performance of artists and musicians from different parts of Ukraine.

#### New Year Kick Off Seminar with "Jeongsong"

On January 10-11, we held the 2-days "New Year Kick Off Seminar 2015" in Vilnius for all Blessed Families in Lithuania.
