

## International Youth Convention 2014 Nepal concludes

**KATHMANDU, NEPAL Nov 7:** Youth Federation for World Peace (YFWP) Nepal chapter and Collegiate Association for Research of Principles (CARP) Nepal organized the International Youth Convention 2014 Nepal at Nepal Academy in Kamaladi on Friday.

The convention, themed on ‘Youth for Nation-Building: Public Mindedness and Sexual Purity’, has issued Kathmandu declaration for the welfare of Nepali youths.

The declaration proclaimed by the convention stresses the need of moral education for youths, their meaningful participation in nation building and proper policy for their welfare.

The international delegation, who attended the program, included over a dozen education experts from India, USA, Korea, Thailand, Japan, and the Philippines.

The keynote speakers including former Indian Ambassador to Nepal K B Rajan, Prof Dr Robert Kittel from the US and CA member Ek Nath Dhakal shared their thoughts on the theme of the convention.

YFWP and World CARP are international youth organizations established in over 120 countries including Nepal. They are both at the forefront of character and peace leadership education for students and young professionals transcending race, religion, culture and nationality.

YFWP, founded by late Dr Sun Myung Moon is a global alliance of young leaders and youth-related organizations dedicated to building a world of peace.

Over 1,200 youths from 60 different colleges across the country, including ambassador for peace appointed by the YFWP attended the convention.
