Prayer Request for Itsuko Bodzewski

Below is a letter from Itsuko's husband, Rick Bodzewski.

To Our Beloved Church Family,

It deeply saddens our hearts to inform all of you that Itsuko has been diagnosed with a degenerative brain disorder called Creutzfeldt–Jakob Disease (CJD). CJD is a terminal illness and Itsuko has been losing mental and physical function over the last couple of months. Itsuko and Rick were part of the 2075 Blessing at MSG. The nurses have now told us that they expect she will pass in the next 4–7 days, but it is very difficult to give an accurate date. Itsuko has been at home for hospice for about 2 weeks now after a month at the University of Washington Medical Center. She will spend her remaining time surrounded by her loving family and friends.

We are asking for prayer support to make Itsuko's time left comfortable and her ascension swift, as well as comfort and strength for the family.

Prayer Vigil Sign-up Sheet for Mrs. Itsuko Bodzewski

Please pray based on Seattle local time (PST) (12:00 AM in Seattle is 3:00 AM in New York)

Traditionally, an around-the-clock prayer vigil begins as soon after the ascension as possible and continues until the Seonghwa Ceremony begins. It is also acceptable for the prayer vigil to cover only the hours from midnight until 4 a.m. on the nights in between the ascension and the Seonghwa Ceremony. People can either pray where the deceased body is (prefered), or in another central location, or in their own homes.

(Suggested) Prayer Vigil format

1. To begin, light the Cheon II Guk candle

2. Greet True Parents and the departed loved one with a half bow (those present facing in the direction of the altar table)

- 3. Light and offer a stick of incense to begin the prayer period
- 4. Sing a Holy Song or songs
- 5. Offer a representative prayer
- 6. Offer a period of individual prayer (aloud or silently)
- 7. Offer a reading (hoondokhae or other appropriate scripture or words)
- 8. Close the prayer period by singing a Holy Song
