The Kingdom itself is governed by those who extend it. If you keep it to yourself, then you are a fool hiding in plain sight. If you allow others to have their kingdoms, then yours will surely be safeguarded. This is why Hyung Jin Nim will successfully reign as the Second King - because he allows us to have our own kingships. God intended that the Kingdom of Heaven *shall* be on earth, not only in Heaven. And He did not create it for just one person or one family or family line, but every person of the creator. A child can only be a child by the allowance of the father and mother. Hence, the reason why True Father always asks us to unite our mind and body. When the two are united on God, then this unity with True Father allows everyone else to be themselves. To be oneself, essentially means to be as God created us to be. This recognizes the parent-child relationship and extends it to our fellow brothers and sisters. Kingdom within is then also viewed in others.

A disparaging fact of this world is that it has fallen; fallen from the ideal. Christ reestablishes our kingship by sharing His Kingship with us. This is held in place when we extend our kingship to others. There is no Kingdom to be had unless there was at least one person to recognize it. Think about this - if Hyung Jin Nim and Yeon Ah Nim just kept the three anointings from Father to themselves and did not attempt to offer us a seat in the same house as them, then no lineage or ideal would prevail since it was not received by the environment which was made to receive the royal family. No one would know of it because they would not have presented the truth and God's love to anyone but themselves. So the royal family would have nothing to reign over because they have no one to share this love and truth with! God exists because we recognize His existence. God is because of us.

God started off as both Sung Sang and Hyung Sang - a seed and an environment. Both are needed for any ideal of love, life, and lineage to flow across. We can think of the Royal Family as the seed and the Sanctuary Church as the environment. This is what keeps it intact - our attendance to them. It shall reign forever and ever when we, the environment, decide to try and extend it by allowing others the opportunity to receive the Kingship of Christ. If we do not extend outwards, then it will be more difficult to maintain the security of the environment and the precious seed. It is because of the seed we have life and the ability to give and receive love. This love is to be given to those around us.

This is why we must reach out; share; extend; offer the Kingdom of God to those around us. It need not be a leap of faith, unless the environment calls for it. It explains to us that each person is loving and lovable and that enemies are a concept that we must overcome. If someone deliberately attacks you, then by all means defend yourself. This is the pattern of the providence of restoration designed by God. Your enemy is someone who is jealous; either of you or what you have; which is in reality the same. Having and being are the same. You cannot be what you do not have, and what you have is what you are. If you have love, you are love. This is the greatest defense against the wiles of the devil. No person can take away what is yours, because it's not theirs. It's a desire to want more than what God has already given - this came from the Archangel Lucifer who was with Adam and Eve and was jealous of the amount of love they were receiving from God.

They were innocent. They have been tricked by a servant of God into thinking that the right way to live life was to disobey God's commandment by being influenced through their immature emotions. They forgot to praise God. They forgot to worship Him and forgot to be grateful to him. So, the example we must follow is the Second King Hyung Jin Nim and the Second Queen Yeon Ah Nim. They both raise up True Father and True Mother Kang. We learn from them to seek our True Parent: True Father and our True Mother Kang united with him. Here we find our Father.
