
No One Should Be Married Without Perfecting One's Responsibility

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After being oriented on the 8 Great Text Books, and also the Teachings of UC Breakaway Groups. My understanding on the 3 Great Blessings remained one and the same.

Take note of this: You will be perfected as an individual within the family, and here are the main applications: Take note further that "Perfection" and "Maturity" in this particular presentation denotes the same thing:

First Blessing, as a Perfected Child and Perfected Sibling, which is attained though maintained purity while still single before marriage and protecting siblings' and extended siblings' purity;

Second Blessing, as a Perfected Spouse and Parent, which is attained through maintained fidelity and right education of one's children including extended children (neighbors children); and

Third Blessing, as a Perfected Co-owner of the Creation, which is attained through proper management of the environment, especially proper use of public fund.

This explains that no one should be married without perfecting one's responsibility as a child and a sibling or without fulfilling the First Blessing, which is fulfilled by going through the 3 stages of growth. There is no maturity in the Formation Stage, hence no one should be allowed to marry while in the realm of Formation Stage in the individual level.
